Also in Yellow Jacket Athletics This Week/ Coming Up

BEREA, OHIO -- Tomorrow night, right here in the Ursprung Gymnasium, the B-W women's basketball team, 2-1, will play host to Grove City (Pa.) at 6:00 p.m. and the 13th-ranked men's basketball team, 4-0 overall, plays host to Oberlin at 8:00 p.m.

This Saturday, December 4, the wrestling team is at the Rochester Institute of Technology Tournament in Rochester, New York. Action begins at 9:30 a.m. The men's basketball team is back in action, right here at Ursprung, as it opens 2004-2005 Ohio Athletic Conference action against Otterbein at 3:00 p.m. In the OAC preseason polls, B-W was picked first and Otterbein second. In addition, the women's basketball team travels to Westerville and will play the Otterbein women at the Rike Center at 3:00 p.m.

The swim teams are currently idle until they travel to Florida during the first week of January. To date, the men are 5-2 overall and have a 3-0 record against OAC teams. The women are 4-3 overall and are also perfect against the OAC with a 3-0 slate.

And in January, the indoor track and field season kicks off when B-W hosts the first of four home meets on Friday, January 14 on the 200-meter Harrison Dillard Track in the B-W Recreation Center.



The Yellow Jacket Wrestling Team Has Competed at the Case Quad and at the Olivet (Mich.) Duals So Far This Winter

BEREA, OHIO -- The Baldwin-Wallace College wrestling team has competed twice so far this winter.

The Yellow Jackets opened the season on Saturday, November 13, when they travelled to University Circle and had a 2-1 record at the annual Case Western Reserve University Quad Meet. The Yellow Jackets defeated Waynesburg (Pa.), 44-12, and host Case, xx-xx, but lost to Mt. St. Joseph, 24-19. The other competition was at the annual Olivet (Mich.) College Quads on Nov. 20. At Olivet, B-W finished 1-4 against a very strong field. In the order of its matches, B-W lost to Wisconsin at Steven's Points, 31-13, Lycoming (Pa.), 37-8, lost to nationally-ranked Augsburg (Minn.), 49-0, lost to host Olivet, 24-16, and beat Rose-Hulman (Ind.), 38-9.

For the weekend, junior 197-pounder **Devin Carman** and junior 285-pounder **Bryan Kmetz** each had 4-1 overall records and freshman 157-pounder **Gino Russo** was 3-1.

Despite the loss to UW-Steven's Point, **Carman** won by major decision and senior 149-pounder **Scott Conrath**, **Russo** and **Kmetz** all won by decision.

Despite the loss to Lycoming, both **Carman** and **Kmetz** each won by major decision.

Despite the loss to Olivet, **Carman** won by superior decision, **Kmetz** and **Russo** won by major decision and sophomore 141-pounder **Joe Smith** won by decision.

In the win versus Rose-Hulman, senior 125-pounder **Mike Ham**, freshman 133-pounder **John Weston** and **Carman** all won by forfeits, sophomore 141-pounder **Rayshawn Eatmon** won by decision, **Russo** won by pin, junior 157-pounder **Steve Vaughn** won by major decision, junior 174-pounder **T. Terry** won by decision and **Kmetz** won by decision.

After two weeks of competition, **Kmetz** tops the team with a 7-1 overall record and .875 winning percentage. **Russo** is second with six wins and a 6-1 record and .857 winning percentage. **Carman** is 5-1 with an .833 winning percentage.

B-W next competes this weekend at the Rochester (N.Y.) Institute of Technology Tournament.
