### Yellow Jacket Wrestlers Hosts Nonleague Foe Thiel College of Pennsylvania Tonight in Ursprung

**BEREA, OHIO** -- The Baldwin-Wallace College wrestling team, 6-12 overall, hosts nonleague foe and nationally-ranked Thiel College of Pennsylvania tonight in the Rudolph Ursprung Gymnasium in the Lou Higgins Center.

The Yellow Jackets last competed last Friday and Saturday (Jan. 13-14) in The Division III National Duals at Lycoming (Pa.) College in Williamsport, Pennsylvania. In its two competitive round matches, B-W lost to nationally-ranked opponents York (Pa.) College, the third seed at the National Duals, and to Oswego State (N.Y.) University, the seventh seed in the tourney. On the second day in its two challenge matches, B-W defeated OAC-rival Muskingum College, 38-9, but lost to Rhode Island College, 23-15. Earlier in the week, B-W lost in OAC dual match competition to nationally-ranked John Carroll University.

Individually at the Duals, B-W was led by seniors 285-pounder **Bryan Kmetz** and 174-pounder **Sterling Sebek** and sophomore 157-pounder **Gino Russo**. All three grapplers each finished with a perfect 4-0 record and had a 5-0 mark for the week overall. In addition at the Duals, junior 165-pounder **T. Terry** posted a 2-1 mark.

**Kmetz** is this week's Ohio Athletic Conference *Wrestler of the Week* for the third time this season and the fifth time in his three-year career. Last week, he posted the 5-0 mark by beating John Francis from JCU, 9-2, and then had a 4-0 marks at the Duals, including one win by pin and another by technical fall. In his three seasons at B-W, **Kmetz** is 68-12 overall. Earlier this season, **Kmetz** was tabbed as the *Most Valuable Wrestler* at the Rochester Institute of Technology Tournament. He is currently ranked seventh in Division III at 285 pounds in the latest Brute-Adidas poll.

To date, **Russo** tops all Yellow Jacket grapplers with 22 wins and a sparkling 22-1 record with a .957 winning percentage. **Kmetz** is second with 19 victories and is 19-1 overall. He also tops the Yellow Jackes with nine pin/ falls and 28 near falls. **Sebek** is third on the squad with 17 wins and is 17-5 overall. Freshman 149-pounder **Mohamed Salem** is fourth with 14 wins and a 14-6 record. Also, freshman 133-pounder **Brian Bucher** is 10-9. Statistically, **Russo** tops the team 81 takedowns. **Salem** has the most escapes with 27. **Bucher** has the most reversals with 20 and is second with 23 near falls.

Next Tuesday, the Yellow Jackets are at home and host OAC rival Wilmington College in the Ursprung Gymnasium at 7:30 p.m. Fans are reminded that the Annual John Summa Memorial Tournament is on February 4.

### Yellow Jacket Winter Sports Notes

#### Women's Basketball Update

The 12th-ranked Yellow Jacket women's basketball team, 14-2 overall and a perfect 9-0 in the Ohio Athletic Conference, hosted a key OAC game today versus Wilmington College and is at OAC-rival John Carroll University next Wednesday (Jan. 25) at 7:30 p.m. The JCU game will be broadcast live on campus radio station WBWC, 88.3 FM.

The B-W women enter today's game with a two-game lead in the OAC Standings.

On Tuesday (Jan. 17), the B-W women defeated Heidelberg College, 90-44, for their fifth straight win. Sophomore forward **Alyson Cotter (Salem)** and freshman guard **Amanda Mondrach (Parma)** led the way in the win as each scored 14 points.

To date, the Yellow Jacket women are led by senior All-OAC and Academic All-OAC point guard **Nikki Altenweg (Perry)** who is scoring 10.6 points per game and is among the school's all-time leaders in steals and assists.

#### The Men's Basketball Update

The 10th-ranked Yellow Jacket men's basketball team, 14-2 overall and leading the OAC with an 8-1 mark, played at Wilmington this afternoon and will host cross-town rival JCU next Wednesday night (Jan. 25) right here in the Ursprung Gymnasium at 7:30 p.m. Fans can listen to the JCU game via the WBWC Web site at [www.wbwc.com](http://www.wbwc.com).

Last Wednesday, B-W defeated Heidelberg, 95-75, for its third straight win. Junior preseason All-American forward **Tori Davis (Elyria)** led the Jackets' with 23 points. In addition, senior forward **Dan Gundert (Wellington)** had 19 points, 10 rebounds, five assists and four steals in the win.

#### The Swimming Update

The Yellow Jacket men's and women's swimming and diving teams hosted OAC rival Ohio Northern University earlier this today in the B-W Natatorium and do not compete again until the OAC Championship Meet at John Carroll from Feb. 10-12.

B-W competed on Wednesday at JCU with the men (7-5 overall and leading the OAC at 3-0) winning and the women (6-6 overall and 2-1 in the OAC) were defeated.

Congratulations to junior swimmer **Alex de la Pena (Elyria)** who is this week's OAC *Men's Swimmer of the Week* and senior **Emily Wood (Carrollton)** who is this week's OAC *Women's Swimmer of the Week*. **de la Pena** won the award for the second time this year and the fourth time in his career. **Wood's** award was her first.

#### The Indoor Track Update

The men's and women's track teams compete in their first meet of the season on January 20 when they host the Mid-January Meet.

This season, the women's team will be looking to defend its OAC Championship indoor title and win its 17th OAC crown in the past 21 years. The team is returning All-OAC competitors seniors **Mary Griglak (Cleveland)**, **Liz Redd (North Canton)**, **Kim Lammers (Liberty Center)**, **Angela Gruss (Tiffin)**, junior All-American **Kara Weaver (Myrtle Creek, Ore.)** and sophomores **Jeanne Osborne (Oak Harbor)**, **Megan Cathcart (Parma)**, and **Kristen Paulsen (Oberlin/ Firelands)**.

The men's team is looking to improve on last year's performance and is returning OAC placers in senior **Josh Svenson (Wadsworth)**, juniors **Sean Johnson (Alliance)**, **Ben Price (Cleveland)**, and **Steve Johnson (Canton)**, sophomores **James Harris-Chappell (Jefferson)**, **Aaron Apathy (Parma)**, and **D.J. Hanigosky (North Royalton)**.

In addition, B-W hosts its annual Mid-February Meet on Feb. 10 and the annual Greater Cleveland College Indoor Track & Field Championship Meet on Feb. 17.

All meets are held on the Harrison Dillard Track inside the Lou Higgins Center. All three home events begin at 5:30 p.m.
