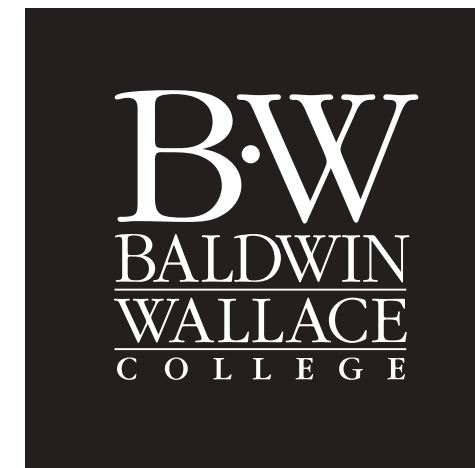

The Yellow Jacket Wrestlers Host OAC and Cleveland Cross-Town Rival John Carroll University

BEREA, OHIO -- The Baldwin-Wallace College wrestling team hosts Ohio Athletic Conference and Cleveland cross-town rival John Carroll University tonight in the Rudolph Ursprung Gymnasium. This is the fifth OAC dual meet of the season for the Yellow Jackets and the 25th overall.

Last season, the Yellow Jackets dropped a close OAC dual match to John Carroll, 20-16, in University Heights. In that match, current junior 149-pounder **Mo Salem** defeated Daniel Mizener, 8-7, and current junior 157-pounder **Joe Incorvaia** shut out Steven Branch, 5-0. In addition, current senior All-American 165-pounder **Gino Russo** and graduated All-American 285-pounder Bryan Kmetz scored major decisions. Unfortunately, **Russo** is injured and will not compete tonight.

The Yellow Jackets enter this match with a 6-17-1 overall and 1-3 OAC mark and last competed in Ada on Tuesday, January 22 against OAC rival Ohio Northern University and lost, 24-9. Despite the loss, three Yellow Jackets earned wins. Junior 133-pounder **Brian Bucher** won by a 5-2 decision, freshman 184-pounder **Andrew Scavuzzo** won his match by a score of 7-1 and senior 197-pounder **Brian Haines** recorded a 13-8 win. **Bucher** improved to 19-5, **Scavuzzo** improved to 17-12 and **Haines** is now 8-11 overall.

After 24 dual matches and one tournament, **Russo**, a third-time OAC Wrestler of the Week this season, leads the team with 22 victories and has an impressive 22-1 overall record and .857 winning percentage. Although **Russo** sat out last Tuesday's match against ONU due to his injury, he still leads the team with 97 takedowns. Freshman **Cory Connell** leads the team with 28 escapes and is 7-8 overall, including a 1-0 OAC dual match mark. **Bucher** leads the squad with 53 near falls, including 31 three-point near falls, and 20 reversals, is second with 19 wins and a .792 winning percentage and third with five falls. Also boasting a winning record are freshman 157-pounder **Korey Leonhard** with a 9-6 slate, senior 174-pounder **Jeremy Feador** with a 13-10 mark and **Scavuzzo**.

Look for veteran **Head Coach Rich Fleming**, the second winningest wrestling coach in school history as he trails only Ohio Wrestling Hall of Famer and the legendary John Summa, to start freshman **Tyler Erwin** at 125 pounds, **Bucher** at 133, sophomore **Eric Schubert** at 141 pounds, senior **Scott Haber** or **Salem** at 149 pounds, **Incorvaia** at 157 pounds, sophomore **Cody Quick** or **Leonhard** at 165 pounds, **Feador** at 174 pounds, **Scavuzzo** or senior **Antonio Campea** at 184 pounds, **Scavuzzo** or **Haines** at 197 pounds and senior **Michael Pelton** at 285 pounds. Senior 141-pounder **Chris Hamad** will miss the match with an injury and junior 197-pound 2007 OAC champ and NCAA Division III national qualifier **Paul Burger** is out for the season due to an injury suffered during football season.

Following tonight's match, B-W will be back in action on Saturday, February 2 when the Yellow Jackets host the 22nd Annual John Summa Memorial Tournament in the Lou Higgins Center Fieldhouse. Action begins at 10:00 a.m. Brockport State (N.Y.) returns as the 11-time tourney champ. **Jeremy Feador** also returns as the 2007 Summa Memorial Tournament *Most Valuable Wrestler* and the *Most Pins in the Fastest Time* Award recipient. B-W ends the regular season on Feb. 12 when it hosts Wilmington College on Seniors' Night at 7:30 p.m. The 2008 OAC Tournament is on Feb. 23 at John Carroll and action begins in the Tony DeCarlo Varsity Center at 10:00 a.m.

Women's Basketball Update

The women's basketball team is ranked 23rd in Division III with a 15-2 record and hosts Ohio Athletic Conference rival Mount Union tomorrow night in the Ursprung Gymnasium at 7:30 p.m.

This Saturday, B-W travels to Ada for a showdown with first place Ohio Northern at 3:00 p.m. B-W, at 8-2 in the OAC, trails ONU by one game and could forge a first place tie with two wins this week. Senior guard **Selena Eskinazi-Budge (Beachwood)** leads the team in scoring at 11.1 points-per-game.

Men's Basketball Update
