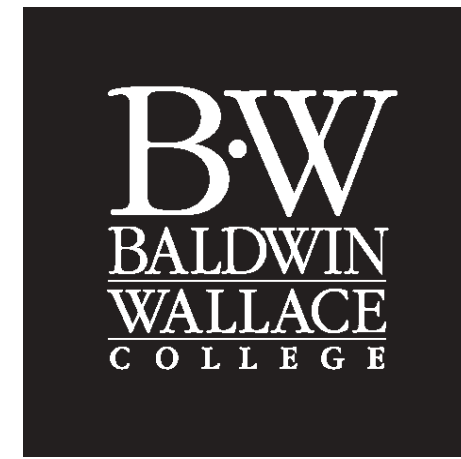

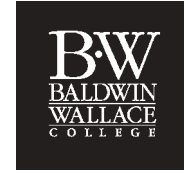

Baldwin-Wallace College Head Coach Rich Fleming



Head Coach Rich Fleming is in his 20th season of coaching the wrestlers at B-W in 2007-2008. Fleming is committed to having championship wrestling at B-W and keeping the Yellow Jackets a power in the Ohio Athletic Conference and at the NCAA Division III level.

Since taking over the program, Fleming has tutored 32 wrestlers to the Division III national tournament, including a national champion. Last year,

Fleming and three of his wrestlers advanced to the Division III National Tournament with two grapplers earning Div. III All-America accolades. In eight of the past nine years, his team has been nationally ranked. A year ago, his team placed second at the prestigious OAC Tournament and finished 14th at the Div. III National Championships.

As a wrestler, Fleming learned that it takes hard work to become a champion. His 123-pound Mid-American Conference title while at Miami of Ohio is evidence of that work ethic. That same work ethic governs B-W wrestling.

Fleming is a 1963 graduate of Miami of Ohio and earned his master's degree from Cleveland State University in 1985. Prior to coming to B-W, he spent 17 years building a powerful program at nearby Parma Senior High School. Fleming is retired as a teacher and has dedicated his time to building the Yellow Jacket program into one of the best in Division III. This is Rich's 43rd coaching wrestling. He has been a head coach 35 of those years. Coach Fleming is in the Ohio Wrestling Hall of Fame.

The Yellow Jackets Open the 2007-2008 Season By Hosting the B-W Quad Meet Today at the Lou Higgins Center

BEREA, OHIO -- The Baldwin-Wallace College wrestling team will look forward to another strong and promising season in 2007-2008. Under the direction of 20-year veteran Head Coach Rich Fleming, B-W will sport a team that has solid veteran leadership, returning upperclass depth and a strong group of newcomers who hope to make B-W even better than a year ago. B-W enters its season-opening tournament ranked 17th in a Division III preseason poll.

Last season, the Yellow Jackets finished with a 12-10 overall record, were 4-2 in Ohio Athletic Conference dual matches, finished second at the OAC Championship Tournament with three individual champions and 14th at the NCAA Division III National Championships with two All-Americans.

This year, the Yellow Jackets return 15 letterman and eight starters and will be led by senior All-American 165-pounder **Gino Russo** and NCAA qualifier **Paul Burger** as well as OAC runner-up **Mo Salem**. In addition, **Eric Schubert**, **Chris Hamed**, **Joe Incorvaia**, **Jeremy Feador** and **Antonio Campea** return as starters from last year's OAC Tournament roster. Overall, 16-of-the-17 returnees from a year ago started at one time or another and the 17th was injured for most of the season.

"We return a solid, veteran group of wrestlers and a strong incoming group of newcomers," said Fleming. "We are looking forward to having another outstanding season. We are just excited to get on the mat and get the season started."

A year ago, **Russo** had a team-leading 24 wins and a 24-7 record enroute to being an All-American. **Burger**, despite missing much of the season with an injury, was 9-3 with five pins. In addition, **Bucher** (22-7) at 133 pounds, **Salem** (23-12) at 149 pounds and **Feador** (20-10) at 174 pounds all had 20 or more wins.

"While **Gino**, **Paul** and **Mo** will be our main leaders, we have plenty of talented young men who have the talent and ability to be successful this winter," said Fleming."

Following its matches today, the Yellow Jacket wrestlers will be back in action on Saturday, November 17 when they travel to Olivet, Michigan to participate in the annual Olivet College Duals at 8:30 a.m. To

Yellow Jacket Sports Roundup

*** The Yellow Jacket football team, 6-3 overall and 5-3 in the Ohio Athletic Conference, is at Capital University today for its final game of the regular season at 1:30 p.m.

Fans can listen to that game on the radio on campus station WBWC, 88.3 FM, or via the WBWC Internet Web site at www.wbwc.com. The pregame show begins at 1:15 p.m.

This week, senior middle linebacker **Luke Chronister (Ashland)** and senior 2-time All-American punter **Kevin Soflkiancs (Middleburg Hts.)** are the OAC Defense and Special Teams Players of the Week, respectively. **Chronister** had a game-high 16 tackles, intercepted a pass and ran the ball twice for first downs on fake punt situations. **Soflkiancs**, who currently leads Division III with a 43.6-yard punting average, punted the ball four times for a 48.2-yard average, including one that stopped at the one yard line.

The win versus Otterbein secured B-W's 40th winning season of football in the last 41 years. Truly a "Tradition of Excellence".

*** The men's and women's cross country teams are competing today at the NCAA Division III Great Lakes Regional Meet at Calvin College in Grand Rapids, Michigan. Two weeks ago, the B-W women won an OAC title and senior **Lindsay Brickner (Lisbon)** was the women's individual champion. All five women's runners finished in the Top-10.

*** The swimming and diving teams are competing today in the Natatorium in a tri-meet versus Ohio Wesleyan University and Washington & Jefferson (Pa.) College that begins at 1:00 p.m. The men, 2-1 overall, are led by this week's OAC Men's Swimmer of the Week, sophomore **Vince Colwell (Parma)**. The women, 1-2 overall, are led by this week's OAC Women's Swimmer of the Week, senior **Stephanie Markley (Mansfield)**.

*** The men's and women's basketball teams begin play on the weekend of Nov. 16-17 with the men at the Penn State Behrend Tournament in Erie, Pennsylvania and the women at the Anderson University Tournament in Anderson, Indiana.

The men return seven lettermen and four starters to last year's team that finished 18-9 overall. All-OAC guard **Brendan Schuler (Fairview Park)** and Academic All-OAC guard **Dennis Santiago (Brook Park)** will lead the way.

The women return 12 letterwinners to its 19-7 squad from a year ago and will be led by junior 2-time All-OAC guard **Amanda Mondrach (Parma)**.

*** The volleyball team ended its season at 18-14 overall. Three outstanding seniors, **Kelsey Hills (Toledo)**, **Betsy Gilbert (Mansfield)** and **Meggie Marten (Bowling Green)** all ended their careers by leading B-W to a four-year record of 88-43 with one OAC regular season title (2005).

*** The men's and women's soccer teams each ended successful seasons. The women finished 11-6-3 overall and the men were 9-6-4 overall. The women had their fourth straight 10-win or more season and the men have now won 50 matches in the past four years. Senior goalie **Michelle Neff (Strongsville)** broke the single-season record for shutouts with 10 and ended her career with 24.

*** Both the men's (29-11-1 record) and women's (15-15) golf teams had a strong fall season and will continue play this spring. Sophomore **Nick Bryan (Zanesville)** had a school-record 74.0 stroke average to lead the men. Senior 3-time All-OAC and 2-time Academic All-OAC student-athlete **Molly Schetz (Canton)** led the women with an 88.0 stroke average.

*** The 2007 indoor track season begins on Friday, January 25 when B-W hosts the annual Mid-January Meet on the Harrison Dillard Track in the fieldhouse of the Higgins Center at 5:30 p.m.
