

## Yellow Jacket Seniors Brian Bucher, Scott Haber and Joe Incorvaia Wrestle Tonight for the Final Time in the Ursprung Gymnasium

**BEREA, OHIO** -- Three Baldwin-Wallace College seniors, 133-pounder **Brian Bucher**, 157-pounder **Scott Haber** and 165-pounder **Joe Incorvaia**, will compete in their final home dual meet as Yellow Jackets. Tonight is Seniors' Night in Berea. The trio will end their home careers on Saturday, February 7 when B-W hosts the 23rd Annual John Summa memorial Tournament in the Higgins Center Fieldhouse.

### Brian Bucher

Brian will earn his fourth varsity letter this season and has a combined 78-33 record in the Brown & Gold. He posted a team-best 23 wins in each of the last two seasons and compiled a 5-1 mark during Ohio Athletic Conference dual match competition in 2007-08. Brian won the 133-pound weight class at the 22nd annual B-W John Summa Memorial Tournament last winter and finished fourth at 133 lbs. at the 2008 OAC Championships. He is first all-time in school history with 186 career near falls. Earlier this season, he was named the OAC *Wrestler of the Week* following his 4-0 performance at the Olivet (Mich.) College Comet Duals on November 22, 2008. Brian is a business administration major. He is the son of Brian and Beth Bucher.



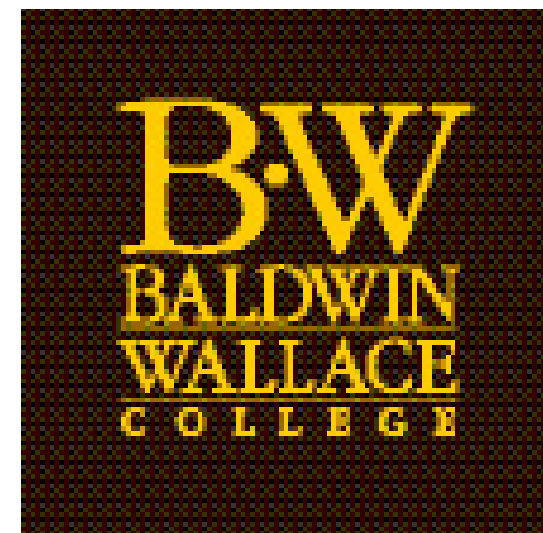
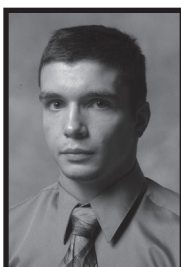
### Scott Haber

Scott will earn his fourth varsity letter this season and has compiled 20 career wins as a Yellow Jacket. He posted two five-win campaigns at 141 pounds as a freshman and a sophomore and moved up to 149 lbs. last winter, where he also totaled five wins. Scott is a Spanish education major. He is the son of Lynn Labusky and Roy Haber.



### Joe Invorvaia

Joe will earn his fourth varsity letter this season and has posted a 48-43 career record as a four-year starter. Joe was 4-0 at 165 pounds as a freshman and posted 11 wins as a sophomore despite battling injuries for most of the season. He earned up 16 wins last season and finished fourth at 157 lbs. at the 2008 OAC Championships. This season, he is second on the squad with 15 wins. Joe is a computer information systems major. He is the son of Frank and Joan Incorvaia.

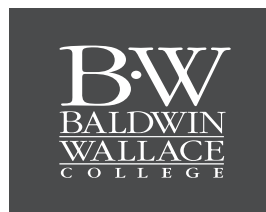

## The Yellow Jackets Host OAC Rival Ohio Northern University on Seniors' Night at Baldwin-Wallace College

**BEREA, OHIO --** The Baldwin-Wallace College wrestling team hosts Ohio Northern University tonight in the Rudolph Ursprung Gymnasium on Seniors' Night. This is the final home dual match for the Yellow Jackets.

Three Yellow Jacket seniors, 133-pounder **Brian Bucher**, 157-pounder **Scott Haber** and 165-pounder **Joe Incorvaia** will compete in their final home dual meet as Yellow Jackets. A profile on each senior can be found on the back outside cover of this program.

The Yellow Jackets enter this match with a 2-18 overall and 0-4 Ohio Athletic Conference record. Last week, B-W had an influx of three new wrestlers who joined the program, including freshman 125-pounder **Jeremy Dombrody** who started and won his first collegiate match. The other additions are freshman 149-pounder **Terence Simon** and freshman 174-pounder **Josef Rubin** from Curita, BRAZIL.

Last season B-W lost in dual match competition to the Polar Bears, 24-9, in the ONU Sports Center in Ada. In that OAC match, **Brian Bucher** defeated ONU's Jeff Penny, 10-8, **Andrew Scavuzzo** earned a 7-1 decision against ONU's Drew Swick, and graduated 184-pounder Brian Haines recorded a 13-8 decision versus ONU's Drew Michel.

In addition to tonight's Seniors' Night match, fans are reminded that the Yellow Jackets will host the 23rd Annual John Summa Memorial Tournament next Saturday, February 7 in the Fieldhouse of the Lou Higgins Recreation Center at 10:00 a.m.

After 20 dual matches and one tournament, **Bucher** leads the team with 18 victories, an 18-7 overall record and an impressive .720 winning percentage for the year and is first in reversals with 27 and near falls with 44. **Scavuzzo** is first on the team with 20 takedowns and second on the team with 17 wins. Freshman **Ryan Tudor** leads the team in escapes with 27 and currently is 5-14.

Look for veteran Head Coach **Rich Fleming**, the second winningest wrestling coach in school history as he trails only Ohio Wrestling Hall of Famer and the legendary John Summa, to start sophomore **Tyler Erwin** at 125 pounds, **Bucher** at 133, junior **Eric Schubert**, freshman **Grant Steward**, or sophomore **Phillip Payne** at 141 pounds, senior **Chris Hamad** or sophomore **Cory Connell** at 149 pounds, senior **Scott Haber** or freshman **Alex Feador** at 157 pounds, **Incorvaia** at 165 pounds, sophomore **Korey Leonhard** or freshman **Michael Brandt** at 174 pounds, **Scavuzzo** at 184 pounds, junior **Cody Quick** or **Tudor** at 197 pounds and 45-year-old junior **Terence Haynes** at 285 pounds.

Following tonight's match the Yellow Jackets will be back in action on Tuesday, Feb. 3 when they travel cross-town to compete against OAC and Cleveland cross-town rival John Carroll University in the Don Shula Sports Center at 7:30 p.m. That match will be broadcast on a tape delayed basis by SportsTime Ohio.
