Two Baldwin-Wallace College Seniors Dress in the Brown & Gold For the Final Time Tonight

BEREA, OHIO -- Tonight, two Baldwin-Wallace College seniors, 141-pound standout **Sayre Wuhr** and backup 285-pounder **Isreal Martin** will dress in the Brown & Gold for a home dual match for the final time. Tonight is Seniors' Night.

Sayre Wuhr came to B-W from Ohio Athletic Conference rival Capital University after Capital disbanded its wrestling program. He was a gift to Rich Fleming and the Yellow Jacket program. This year, **Sayre** is having his finest season as a collegian and he will battle for an OAC title and spot at the NCAA Division III National Tournament.

Sayre is a health and physical education major. As a sophomore, **Sayre** posted a 17-10 record in the 141-pound weight class. Last season, despite missing part of the season with an injury, he posted a solid 15-6 record. This year, **Sayre** is having his best season as a collegian. He is second on the team with 18 victories and is 18-5 overall. **Sayre's** career record at B-W is 50-21.

Last season **Sayre** placed second at the Heidelberg Invitational and third at both RIT and ONU tournaments. This season, **Sayre** won an individual title at 141 pounds at the Elmhurst (Ill.) Tournament, had a perfect 4-0 record and earned OAC Wrestler of the Week honors for his efforts at the Division III National Duals at Lycoming (Pa.) and placed fourth at the RIT tourney. He enters tonight's match with JCU riding a 10-match winning streak.

Israel Martin is an art education major who is the backup to sophomore Bryan Kmetz at 285 pounds. He is competing in wrestling for the first time this year after previously playing football and competing on the track team for one season each. **Israel** is a member of the Lambda Chi Alpha fraternity and is a Dean's List student. This season, **Isreal** is 5-2 overall following a 2-2 record at last weekend's Elmhurst Tournament.

Also in Yellow Jacket Athletics This Week

BEREA, OHIO -- Tomorrow evening, the Baldwin-Wallace College women's basketball team, 16-3 overall and 9-3 in the OAC, hosts Ohio Athletic Conference rival Heidelberg College at 7:30 p.m. in the Ursprung Gymnasium while the men's basketball team, 14-5 overall and 9-3 in the OAC, is in Tiffin to play the Student Princes. On Friday, the B-W indoor track team travels cross-town to compete at the Case Western Reserve University Spartan Invitational and then is in Kent, Ohio on Saturday to run at the Kent State Open Meet. The swimming teams are currently idle and will not compete again until Feb. 12-14, when they are at the 2004 OAC Championship Meet. The women finished the regular season 8-6 overall and a perfect 4-0 in the OAC and the men were 7-6 overall and 3-1 in the OAC. Also on Saturday, the men's and women's basketball teams play a doubleheader at Marietta College with the women tipping off at 1:00 p.m. and the men at 3:00 p.m.



The Undefeated OAC Yellow Jackets Face the Blue Streaks in a Cross-Town and Ohio Athletic Conference Rivalry

BEREA, OHIO -- The Baldwin-Wallace College wrestling team enters tonight's match against Ohio Athletic Conference and Cleveland cross-town rival John Carroll University undefeated in OAC action. Tonight's battle will go a long way toward determining the OAC regular season champion. Unfortunately, both teams enter this match with numerous injuries and other health problems.

JCU has been OAC regular season champion eight of the past 13 years. Baldwin-Wallace has not won an OAC Championship since 1973. In the 1960s through the 1980s, B-W was one of the most dominant programs in the OAC. A year ago, JCU won the OAC Tournament and B-W finished a surprising second.

B-W enters tonight's match with a 6-3 overall and 3-0 OAC mark. JCU is 8-6 overall and 2-1 in the OAC. The Yellow jackets last competed on Saturday when they finished fifth of 15 teams at the Elmhurst College Al Hanke Invitational Tournament in Elmhurst, Illinois. Highlighting the tourney for B-W was senior 141-pounder Sayre Wuhr. Wuhr won an individual title at 141 pounds and was dominant in all four of his matches. He was 5-0 last week (with a technical fall win against Muskingum last Tuesday in a 23-19 B-W win) and has won 10 straight matches. In addition, sophomore 285-pounder Bryan Kmetz was 3-1 and placed second. His only loss was in sudden death overtime. Sophomore 174-pounder T. Terry and junior 184-pounder Sterling Sebek each placed fourth and sophomore 133-pounder Jared Selover was sixth.

To date, sophomore 185-pounder Bryan Kmetz tops the Yellow Jackets in victories with 20 and a 20-3 record with an .870 winning percentage. Wuhr is second with 18 wins and an 18-5 mark. Junior 165-pounder Joe Heiland is third with 16 wins and is 16-5 and Selover is 15-5 overall, including a 4-1 mark at 133 pounds.
