



# How B-W's Other 2002-2003 Winter Sports Teams Are Doing



## Men's Basketball

The Yellow Jacket men's basketball team, 2-1 overall, plays at home in the "friendly confines" of the Rudolph Ursprung Gymnasium tomorrow night when it hosts Bethany (WV) College at 7:30 p.m.

To date, the Yellow Jackets split a pair of games and finished second at the season-opening Mt. St. Joseph Tournament in Cincinnati and then beat Thiel College in Greenville, Pennsylvania last Saturday, 73-71. Against Thiel, sophomore forward **Thad Davis (Elyria/ Open Door)** led the way with a season-high 23 points, and he stole a pass at the end of the game to save the win. He was joined in double figures by senior three-time All-Ohio Athletic Conference forward **Shawn McCormick (Massillon Jackson)** with 17 points, senior two-time Academic All-OAC guard **Jon Carroll (Berea/ Midpark)** with 15 and junior forward **Eric Reminder (Brunswick)** with 10.

After three games, **McCormick** tops the team in scoring average with 21.3 points per game. He is followed by **Davis** with 19.0 points ppg. and a team-leading 9.3 rebounds per game. **Carroll** is third at 13.7 ppg. and tops the team with six three-pointers. **Reminder** averages 10.0 ppg.

## Women's Basketball

The 11th-ranked Yellow Jackets women's basketball team opened its season when it captured the Second Annual Greater Cleveland College Tip-Off Tournament at the Ursprung Gymnasium in Berea on November 22-23. In the first round, B-W beat Oberlin College, 71-50, and then defeated 16th-ranked and Cleveland cross-town rival Case Western Reserve University, 62-45, in the championship game.

B-W was led by **Stephanne Musser** and **Erika Schultz** as both players were named to the all-tournament team. **Musser** had a team-high 13 points in the win versus Oberlin and added 12 points to tie **Schultz** for team-high scoring honors in the win versus CWRU. For the tournament, **Schultz** had 20 pints and 12 rebounds to pace B-W's inside game.

In two games, **Musser** tops the team in scoring with 12.5 points per game and **Schultz** is second at 10.0 ppg. **Sarah Gordon** and **Karissa Kusick** are tied for third at 9.0 ppg. and freshman backup center **Lindsay Mamula** and **Natalie Winkelfoos** are tied for fifth at 7.0 ppg. **Holly Koepp** tops the team in rebounding with 9.5 rpg. and **Schultz** is second at 6.0 rpg. **Gordon** has the most assists with seven and **Schultz** the most steals with six.

## Men's and Women's Swimming and Diving

The Yellow Jacket's swimming teams are idle until December 6 and 7 when they swim at the Depauw (Ind.) Invitational Meet. The women's swimming and diving teams have a 5-3 dual meet record and have beaten OAC rivals Mt. Union and Wilmington and nonleague rivals Hiram, Alma (Mich.) and Oberlin. The losses are to Division I Cleveland State, Div. I Marshall (W. Va.) and Div. II Gannon (Pa.). The men have won against Mt. Union but have lost to CSU, Gannon, Alma, Hiram, Oberlin and Wilmington. Individually in all three meets, sophomore **Kristen Showalter (Bowling Green)** has been the top swimmer and has won two events individually in six of eight dual meets.

## Men's and Women's Indoor Track and Field

The indoor track and field teams do not open the 2003 season until January 24. The Yellow Jacket women are seeking a 16th OAC title and the men are expected to battle for OAC honors as well. Individual champions **Lynn Katanik (Parma/ Padua)** in the 1500 meters, **Nicole Drouhard (Austintown Fitch)** in the 5000 meters and **Tatum Gruskiewicz (Pymatuning Valley)** in the 500 meter dash all return. B-W hosts the 2003 OAC Championship Meet on February 28-March 1.

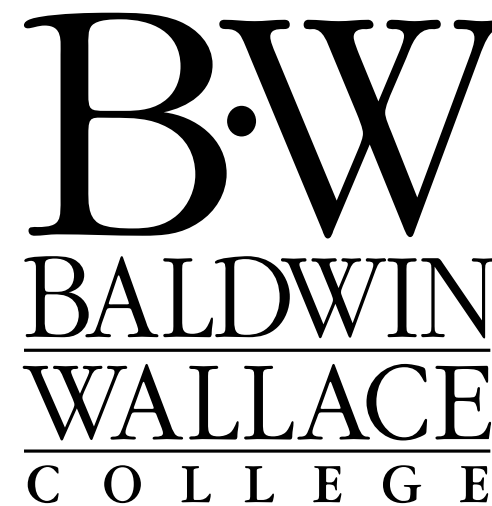

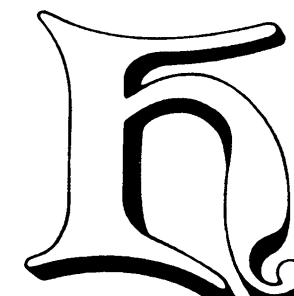

### Baldwin-Wallace College Hosts Heidelberg in the Ohio Athletic Conference Opener for Both Schools

**BEREA, OHIO** -- The Baldwin-Wallace College wrestling team will open its 2002-2003 home and Ohio Athletic Conference schedule tonight against Heidelberg College in the Ursprung Gymnasium. It is the second

part of tonight's women's basketball and wrestling doubleheader. Earlier tonight, the 11th-ranked B-W women's basketball team played against Wittenberg University.

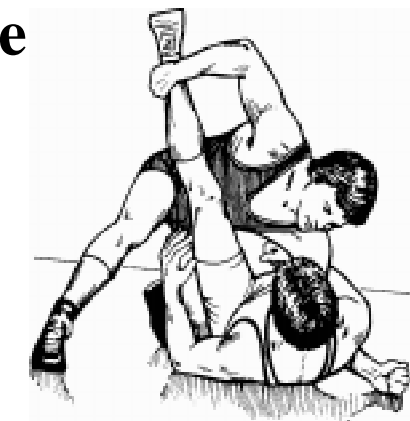
The Yellow Jackets are coming off a 5-13 record in 2001-2002 and are looking for a much better season. B-W has both a bevy of solid returning upperclass wrestlers who have gained a year of experience and are healthy and an outstanding corps of first-year wrestlers that has Head Coach Rich Fleming excited about this winter.

The B-W wrestling team enters its OAC opener with a 3-0 dual match record following a sweep at the November 23 Case Western Reserve University Quad Meet. At CWRU, B-W beat the host school (36-10), Thiel College of Pennsylvania (36-15) and Waynesburg (Pa.) College (46-6). Four Yellow Jacket grapplers finished with perfect 3-0 marks. They were freshman 125 pounder **Jared Selover**, sophomore 174-pounder **Sterling Sebek**, junior 165 pounder **Joe Heiland** and senior heavyweight **Greg Hartlaub**. **Hartlaub** led the way as he pinned two opponents and had a major decision win in his other match.

After facing Heidelberg tonight, the Yellow Jackets will then prepare to travel to Rochester, New York this weekend to take part in the Rochester Institute of Technology Tournament on Saturday at 9:00 a.m.
