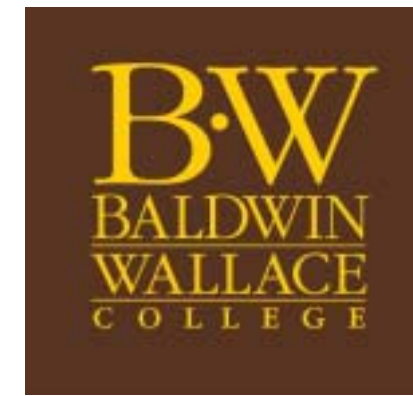

The Yellow Jacket Wrestlers Host Non-league Foe Thiel College of Pennsylvania Tonight at Ursprung

BEREA, OHIO -- The Baldwin-Wallace College wrestling team hosts non-league foe Thiel College of Pennsylvania tonight in the Rudolph Ursprung Gymnasium in Berea at 7:00 p.m. This is second of two matches this season between the two schools.

In the first match between the Yellow Jackets and Tomcats at Thiel on December 8, 2007, Thiel was victorious by a 30-9 score. In that match, B-W was paced by victories from junior 157-pounder **Joe Inocorvia**, senior 165-pound Division III All-American **Gino Russo** and freshman 184-pounder **Andrew Scavuzzo**.

The Yellow Jackets enter this match with a 5-16-1 overall record and 1-2 in the Ohio Athletic Conference as they last competed at home on Wednesday against OAC rival Mount Union College and lost, 20-18. Despite the loss, four Yellow Jackets earned wins. Junior 133-pounder **Brian Bucher** won by a 5-2 decision, **Incorvaia** won a 5-0 decision, senior 174-pounder **Jeremy Feador** earned a pin in 4:24 and senior 285-pounder **Mike Pelton** pinned his opponent in 5:06. The heartbreaker in that match was when **Gino Russo** injured himself in the first minute of the 165-pound match and ended it with a 13-12 loss. He may be lost until either the OAC Tournament or for the season. That is a tough blow when you consider that **Gino** entered that match unbeaten at 22-0 and was ranked No.2 in Div. III in the National Wrestling Coaches Association/ Brute-adidas poll.

After 22 dual matches and one tournament, **Russo**, this week's OAC *Wrestler of the Week* (for the third time this season) leads the team with 22 victories and an impressive overall record of 22-1. **Russo** also tops B-W with 97 takedowns and is second on the team with six pins. **Bucher** is second with 17 wins (17-5 overall) and is first in reversals with 19 and near falls with 50, including 38 three-point moves. **Feador** is 12-9 overall and leads the team in pins with seven. Also with winning records are **Scavuzzo** at 15-12 overall and freshman **Korey Leonhard** at 8-5 overall. Freshman 141-pounder **Cody Connell** leads the team in escapes with 28.

Look for veteran **Head Coach Rich Fleming**, the second winningest wrestling coach in school history as he trails only Ohio Wrestling Hall of Famer and legend John Summa, to start **Erwin** at 125 pounds, **Bucher** at 133 pounds, sophomore **Eric Schubert** at 141 pounds, senior **Scott Haber** or junior All-OAC grappler **Mo Salem** at 149 pounds, **Incorvaia** at 157 pounds, sophomore **Cody Quick** or freshman **Korey Leonhard** at 165 pounds, **Feador** at 174 pounds, **Scavuzzo** or senior **Antonio Campea** at 184 pounds, **Scavuzzo** or senior **Brian Haines** at 197 pounds and **Pelton** at 285 pounds. Senior 141-pounder **Chris Hamad** will miss the match with an injury and junior 197-pound 2007 OAC champ and NCAA Division III national qualifier **Paul Burger** is out for the season due to an injury suffered during football season. Our hearts also go out to **Paul** as his father passed away last week.

Following tonight's match, B-W will be back in action on Tuesday when they travel to Ada, Ohio to face OAC rival Ohio Northern University at 7:30 p.m. The next home match for the Yellow Jackets is on Tuesday, Jan. 29, when B-W hosts OAC and Cleveland cross-town rival John Carroll University at 7:30 p.m. B-W wrestling fans are also reminded that the 22nd Annual John Summa Memorial Tournament is on Saturday, Feb. 2 and begins at 10:00 a.m. in Ursprung Gym.

Women's Basketball Update

The 15th-ranked women's basketball team played at Marietta College this afternoon. The Yellow Jackets, currently 13-2 overall and second in the OAC at 6-2, play their next game next Saturday, January 26 at Captial University at 3:00 p.m. Senior guard **Selena Eskinazi-Budge (Beachwood)** tops the team in scoring at 11.7 points per game. Men's Basketball Update
