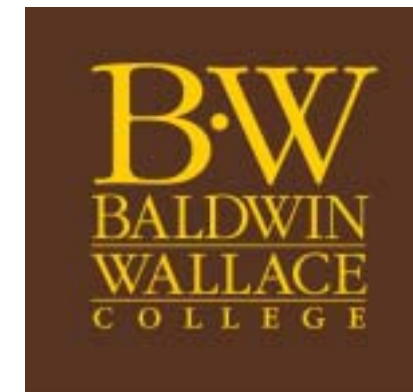

The 16th-ranked Yellow Jacket women's basketball team 19-2 overall and in first place in the Ohio Athletic Conference with a 12-2 record, hosts Otterbein College tomorrow night in the Ursprung Gymnasium at 7:30 p.m. You can listen to that game on the Internet at www.wbwc.com. The women last played on Saturday when they defeated Wilmington College, 71-55, in Berea. In that game, senior forward **Carly Flowers (North Baltimore)** came off the bench to score a game-high 15 points and lead the way to victory.

Men's Basketball Update

The men's basketball team, 8-13 overall and 5-9 in the OAC, plays at Otterbein tomorrow night at 7:30 p.m. You can listen to that game on campus radio station WBWC, 88.3 FM, and/or via the WBWC Web site at www.wbwc.com. The Yellow Jacket Wrestlers Host Ohio Athletic Conference Foe Wilmington College on Seniors' Night in Berea

BEREA, OHIO -- The Baldwin-Wallace College wrestling team hosts Ohio Athletic Conference foe Wilmington College tonight in the Rudolph Ursprung Gymnasium in Berea at 7:30 p.m. This is the final regular season dual match of the season for each team and the last regular season home match for the Yellow Jackets. It is Seniors' Night. Prior to the match, the College will honor its six outstanding senior grapplers. They are **Antonio Campea**, **RayShawn Eatmon**, **Jeremy Feador**, **Brian Haines**, **Mike Pelton** and **Gino Russo**.

Last Season, the Yellow Jackets won the OAC dual match against Wilmington, 45-6, in Wilmington. In that match, current **Chris Hamad** pinned current sophomore Mark Sedziol in two minutes 46 seconds, **Gino Russo** defeated Drew Thomas, 8-6, current junior 197-pounder **Paul Burger**, who was forced to sit out this season due to an injury, pinned current sophomore Jon Waggy in 3:20.

The Yellow Jackets enter this match with a 6-18-1 record in duals, including a 1-4 mark in the Ohio Athletic Conference.

B-W last competed on Feb. 2 in the 22nd Annual John Summa Memorial Tournament held in Berea. At the Summa tourney, the Yellow Jackets finished a strong third as a team and missed tying for second place by one point, and current junior 133-pounder **Brian Bucher**, **Antonio Campea** at 174 pounds and **Brian Haines** at 197 pounds each won an individual title, **RayShawn Eatmon** (149) and **Jeremy Feador** (174) each placed second, junior **Mo Salem** (149), junior **Joe Incorvaia** (157) and freshman **Andrew Scavuzzo** (184) each placed third and freshman **Tyler Erwin** (125) was fourth. Highlighting the tournament was the 174-pound championship match between **Campea** and **Feador** and **Haines** pinning his opponent in the 197-pound title tilt.

After 25 dual matches and one tournament, **Russo** leads with 22 victories and an impressive 22-1 overall record. **Bucher** is a close second with 21 wins, **Scavuzzo** is third with 18 and **Feador** is fourth with 15. **Russo** tops the team with 97 takedowns, **Cory Connell** leads with 28 escapes, **Bucher** has the most reversals with 23 and near falls with 56 and **Feador** has the most falls with eight.

Look for veteran Head Coach Rich Fleming, the second winningest head coach in school history as he trails only Ohio Wrestling Hall of Famer and legend John Summa, to start to start freshman **Erwin** at 125 pounds (0-1 in OAC matches), **Bucher** (4-1 versus the OAC) or sophomore **Phillip Payne** at 133 pounds, sophomore **Eric Schubert** (0-4 vs. the OAC) or junior **Chris Hamad** at 141 pounds, junior **Scott Haber** (1-2 vs. the OAC), **Salem** (0-1 vs. the OAC), **Connell** or **Eatmon** (0-1 vs. the OAC) at 149 pounds, **Incorvaia** (3-2 vs. the OAC) at 157 pounds, sophomore **Cody Quick** or freshman **Korey Leonhard** (0-2 vs. the OAC) at 165 pounds, **Feador** (3-2 vs. the OAC) or **Campea** at 174 pounds, **Scavuzzo** (3-2 vs. the OAC) or **Campea** at 184 pounds, **Scavuzzo** or **Haines** (2-2 vs. the OAC) at 197 pounds and senior **Michael Pelton** (2-2 vs. the OAC) at 285 pounds.

Following tonight's match B-W will compete in the 2008 OAC Championship Tournament held at John Carroll University on Saturday, February 23 at 10:00 a.m. A year ago, B-W placed second at the OAC tourney and had three champs and NCAA Division III National qualifiers.
