## Women's Basketball

The Yellow Jacket women's basketball team, 8-4 overall and 4-1 in the Ohio Athletic Conference, is in Alliance tomorrow night to play unbeaten Mount Union College at 7:30 p.m. Last Saturday, January 2, the B-W women defeated OAC-rival Marietta College, 94-78, in the Ursprung Gymnasium in Berea. Leading the way was sophomore **Katie Heinlen (Bucyrus/ Wynford)** had a career-high 22 points and nine rebounds. The B-W women are home this Saturday to face Muskingum University at 3:00 p.m. in Berea in a game that will be taped and shown on SportsTime Ohio on a delay basis.

On Saturday, Jan. 16, the B-W women host the Second Annual "Take a Kid to the Game" Day and that contest also will be televised by STO.

## Swimming and Diving

The swimming and diving teams are currently wrapping up two weeks of training and meets in Florida. They compete this Friday, Jan. 8 against Ramapo (N.J.) and then return home this Sunday, Jan. 10. B-W next competes up north on Jan. 15 at cross-town rival Case Western Reserve University at 6:00 p.m. The next home meet is on Jan. 23

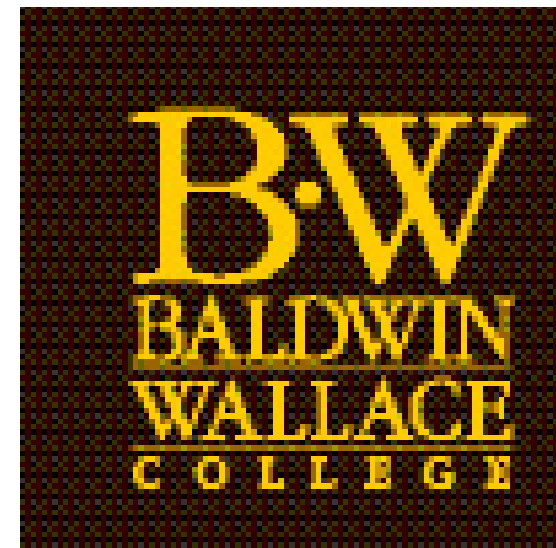
when the Yellow Jackets host OAC-rival Ohio Northern University at 1:00 p.m.

## Men's Basketball

The men's basketball team, 7-5 overall and 2-3 in the OAC, hosts arch-rival Mt. Union at home tomorrow night at 7:30 p.m. in the Ursprung Gym. The men last played on January 3 when they beat Alma (Mich.) College, 73-73, in Alma. Leading the way was senior All-OAC Forward **Kyle Brown (Strongsville)** with 17 points and five three-pointers. Also last week, the men won the Thomas More (Ky.) Coach Connor Classic with wins against Indiana University East and the host school. The three-game winning streak is the longest this season. Next Saturday, the men play at Muskingum University in New Concord at 3:00 p.m. The next home game is on Wednesday, Jan. 13 when B-W plays Ohio Northern University in the Ursprung Gym at 7:30 p.m.

### The Yellow Jackets Host Wilmington College in an OAC Dual Match Tonight at the Lou Higgins Center

**BEREA, OHIO** -- The Baldwin-Wallace Yellow Jackets, 2-5 overall, host Ohio Athletic Conference rival Wilmington College tonight in its 2009-10 OAC dual match opener in the Rudolph Ursprung Gymnasium of the Lou Higgins Center in Berea.

The Quakers enter tonight's match at 0-2 overall and has already competed in one OAC match and is 0-1. The Yellow Jackets last competed on December 5, 2009 when they finished seventh of 10 teams at the annual Rochester (N.Y.) Institute of Technology Tournament. *Please view the details of the tournament on the next page of this program.*

B-W is led by junior 197-pounder **Tristan Stoll**, junior 174-pound 2009 OAC champ and NCAA Division III national qualifier **Andrew Scavuzzo**, sophomore heavyweight **Ryan Jones** and junior 133-pounder **Phillip Payne**. To date, **Stoll** posts an overall record of 7-1 and is second on the team with three pins. **Scavuzzo** is 9-2 overall and 8-2 at 174 pounds with two pins. **Jones** is 8-3 overall with three pins and **Payne** is 7-3 with a team-high 14 takedowns. Freshman 133-pounder **Danny Huffman** has a team-high four pins.

In terms of a starting lineup, look for sophomore **Jeremy Dombrady** to be at 125 pounds, **Phil Payne** at 133, **Eric Schubert** or **Grant Steward** at 141, **Steward** or one of two freshmen, **Danny Huffman** or **Zander Habash** at 149, junior **Korey Leonard** at 157, freshman **Joe Georgian** or sophomore **Mike Hosta** at 165, **Andrew Scavuzzo** at 174, **Hosta** or **Scavuzzo** at 184, **Tristian Stoll** at 197 and **Ryan Jones** at 285.

In the last meeting between B-W and Wilmington on December 2, 2009, the Quakers edged the Yellow Jackets, 24-21, in Wilmington. B-W received victories from then junior **Eric Shubert** 141pounds and then sophomore **Andrew Scavuzzo** at 184 pounds.

Following tonight's match, the B-W grapplers have tomorrow off and then face Central College of Iowa in Berea on Thursday at 1:00 p.m. After travelling to New Concord to face Muskingum University in an OAC dual match on Jan. 12, to Williamsport, Pennsylvania on Jan. 15-16 to compete in the annual Lycoming College Budd Whitehall Duals and to Tiffin to face OAC foe Heidelberg University on Jan. 19, the Yellow Jackets are next at home on Tuesday, January 26 against OAC arch-rival Mount Union College at 7:30 p.m.

### The Yellow Jackets Last Competed on December 5 in Rochester, N.Y.

**BEREA, OHIO** -- The Baldwin-Wallace College wrestling team last competed on December 5, 2009 when it finished seventh of 10 teams at the annual Rochester (N.Y.) Institute of Technology Tournament.

The Yellow Jackets had 49.5 total points and were led by junior 197-pounder **Tristan Stoll**, junior 174-pounder **Andrew Scavuzzo** and sophomore 285-pounder **Ryan Jones**.

**Stoll** was 4-1 on the day. He earned two major decisions in rounds one and two by scores of 18-7 and 16-6 before losing 8-2 in round three. In the consolation bracket, he won by pin (1:23) and by an 8-1 decision to finish third.

**Scavuzzo** posted a 2-2 record and placed fourth at 174 lbs. He received a bye into round two and won by an 8-5 decision before falling 3-2 in round three. In the consolation bracket, he won by pin (6:02) and lost by a 4-0 decision to place fourth.

**Jones** also received a bye into round two and won by pin (2:17) before falling 2-1 in round three. In consolation action, he won 5-2 and lost 9-2 to finish fourth.

In addition for B-W, junior 157-pounder **Korey Leonhard** finished the day 2-2. Posting 1-2 records were sophomore 125-pounder **Jeremy Dombrady**, junior 133-pounder **Phil Payne**, sophomore 165-pounder **Michael Hosta** and freshman 165-pounder **Joe Georgian**.
