

# How B-W's Other 2002-2003 Winter Sports Teams Are Doing



## Men's Basketball

The Yellow Jacket men's basketball team, 7-6 overall and 3-3 in the OAC, is at John Carroll tonight for an OAC game that begins at 7:30 p.m. To date, the Yellow Jacket men are led in scoring by senior three-time All-OAC forward **Shawn McCormick (Massillon Jackson)** with 20.2 points per game. In addition, **McCormick** is also sixth all-time in school history in scoring and enters tonight's game with 1,607 career points.

This Saturday, the men will be home to play Muskingum at 3:00 p.m. Prior to that game, the College will honor veteran **Head Coach Steve Bankson** on achieving his 600th career victory.

## Women's Basketball

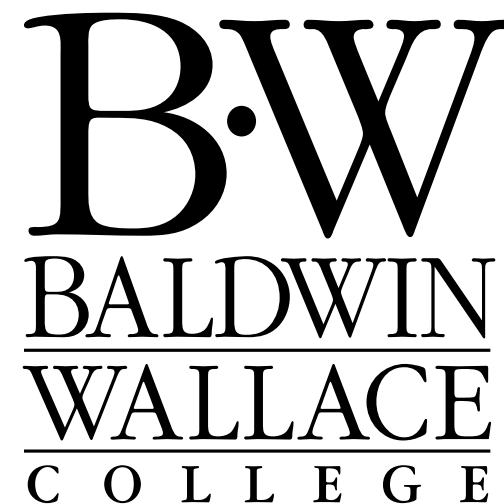
The 10th-ranked Yellow Jackets women's basketball team, 12-1 overall and in first place in the OAC with a 5-1 mark, hosts OAC and Cleveland cross-town rival John Carroll University tomorrow night in the Ursprung Gymnasium at 7:30 p.m. The B-W women have won six straight games, including a 3-0 mark and the title at the Surf & Slam Tournament in San Diego, California from Dec. 27-30, 2002. Senior two-time All-OAC forward Holly Koepp (Lorain Catholic) is this week's OAC Player of the Week for her efforts last week in wins against Ohio Northern (80-62) and Capital (71-60). The women are at Muskingum on Saturday at 3:00 p.m.

## Men's and Women's Swimming and Diving

The swimming and diving teams will compete this weekend. On Friday, the Yellow Jackets will host Washington & Jefferson (Pa.) in a dual meet in the B-W Natatorium at 5:00 p.m. On Saturday, B-W will travel west to the University of Findlay for a dual meet at 1:00 p.m. To date, the defending OAC-champion B-W women's team is 6-4 overall and 2-1 in the OAC, and the men are 2-7 overall and 1-2 in the OAC. Both teams earned wins last Saturday against Bethany (W.Va.) with both senior **Steve Stewart (North Canton/ McKinley)** and freshman **Emily Wood (West Carrollton)** each winning two events individually and also swimming on a winning relay team.

## Men's and Women's Indoor Track and Field

The 2003 indoor track season begins on Friday, January 24, with an open team meet in Berea. It is the first of six home meets this winter and culminates with the OAC Indoor Championship Meet as a part of the OAC Winter Championships Festival in Berea on February 28 and March 1. The Yellow Jacket women enter the 2003 season as the 14-time defending OAC champions and will be led by returning OAC champions and seniors **Lynn Katanik (Parma Padua)**, **Tara Gruskiewicz (Williamsfield/ Pymatuning Valley)** and **Nicole Drouhard (Austintown Fitch)**. The men will be led by junior **Alex Johnson (Berea/ Olmsted Falls)**. Last weekend, at the Kent State Black Squirrel Meet, **Johnson** was ninth in the shot put.

### Baldwin-Wallace College Hosts Ohio Athletic Conference Foe Muskingum Tonight at Ursprung



**BEREA, OHIO** -- Tonight, the Baldwin-Wallace College wrestling team will play host to OAC opponent Muskingum College, in the Ursprung gymnasium. Next Saturday, January 21, B-W will travel to face cross-town rival John Carroll University, in University Heights, for a 7:30 match.

The Yellow Jackets enter tonight's dual match with a 7-2 overall and 2-0 Ohio Athletic Conference record following a 2-2 record at the Division III National Dual Match Championships at Lycoming College in Williamsport, Pa. Leading the way at the Duals for B-W was senior 133-pounder **Jeff Varney**, junior 165-pounder and this week's OAC *Wrestler of the Week* **Joe Heiland** and senior 174-pounder **Dan DiSalvo** all with perfect 4-0 records. Heiland was 5-0 last week with two pins enroute to winning his second career OAC *Wrestler of the Week* award.

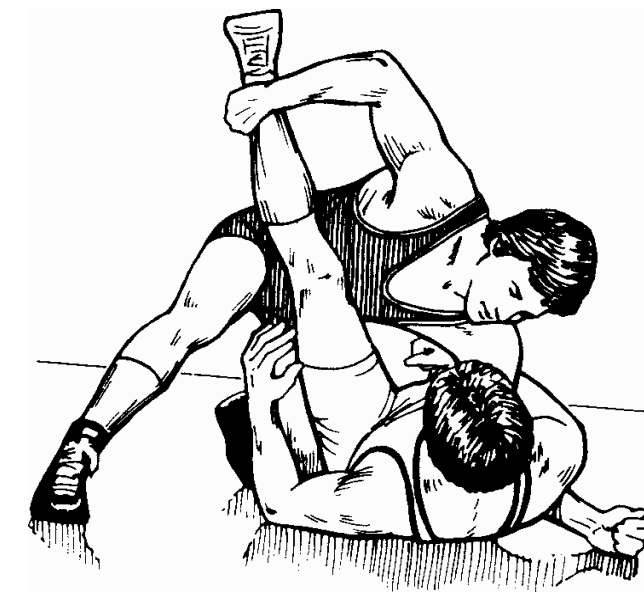
In addition to **Varney**, **Heiland** and **DiSalvo**, freshman 125-pounder **Jared Selover** and senior heavyweight **Greg Hartlaub** each had a 3-1 mark and freshman 197-pounder **Devin Carman** was 2-1.

To date, **Head Coach Rich Fleming** and his young Yellow Jacket squad have shown much improvement. **Selover** tops the team with 21 wins, a 21-2 record and a .913 winning percentage. **Hartlaub** is second with 18 wins, an 18-5 slate and a team-leading nine falls. **Heiland** is third in wins with 17, has a 17-4 mark, including nine straight victories and a team-leading 56 takedowns. **Carman** and **Varney** are tied for fourth with 15 wins each. **Carman** is 15-3 and has the second best winning percentage at .833, and **Varney** is 15-7 overall. Junior 141-pounder **Sayre Wuhr** is sixth with 14 wins and a 14-4 mark at 141 pounds.

Following the John Carroll match, the Yellow Jackets will travel to Elmhurst (Ill.) College, February 1, to compete in the Al Hanke Tournament.
