



How B-W's Other 2003 Winter Sports Teams Are Doing



Men's Basketball

The Yellow Jacket men's basketball team, 11-8 overall and 7-5 in the OAC, hosts Ohio Athletic Conference rival Heidelberg College tomorrow night in the Rudolph Ursprung Gymnasium at 7:30 p.m. That game can be heard on campus radio station WBWC, 88.3 FM, and via the College Internet Web site on a delay basis and immediately following the women's game on WBWC (7:30 pm. air time). To date, senior **Shawn McCormick (Massillon Jackson)** tops the team in scoring with 19.9 points per game and enters the game with 1,723 career points to rank fourth all-time in school history. In addition, senior guard **Jon Carroll (Berea/ Midpark)** enters the game with 998 career points.

Women's Basketball

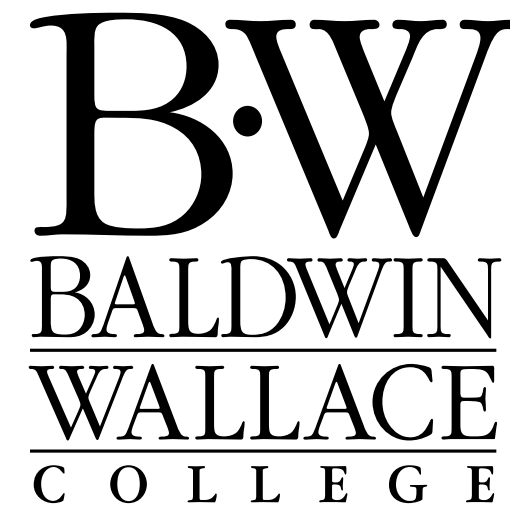
The Yellow Jacket women's basketball team, 17-2 overall and 10-2 in the OAC, play tonight at Heidelberg at 7:30 p.m. That game can be heard LIVE on campus radio station WBWC, 88.3 FM, and on the College Internet Web site at www.bw.edu/athletics. The B-W women enter the game ranked second in the NCAA Division III Great Lakes Region and with the ability to control their own destiny in this year's NCAA Division III National Tournament. If B-W wins the rest of its games, it will be the top seed in the Great Lakes Region. To date, senior three-time All-OAC forward **Holly Koepp (Lorain Catholic)** tops the team in scoring (12.7 ppg.) and rebounding (8.1 rpg.). The B-W women will play at home next Tuesday against Ohio Northern at 7:30 p.m.

Men's and Women's Swimming and Diving

Tomorrow in University Heights and at John Carroll University, the B-W swimming and diving teams will begin competition in the 2003 OAC Championships. The Yellow Jacket women are the defending OAC champions. Leading the way will be sophomore **Kristen Showalter (Bowling Green)** who returns as the individual champion in both the 200 and 500-yard freestyle events. She also swam on three winning relay teams, including on the 200-yard medley relay team with returning teammates, sophomore **Carey McDermott (Salem)** and junior **Maryanda Yocum (Canal Winchester/ Pickerington)**.

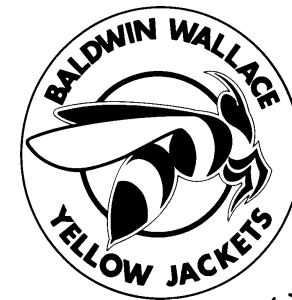
Men's and Women's Indoor Track and Field

The indoor track teams will compete this Friday at a meet at cross-town rival Case Western Reserve University. It is the third indoor competition this winter. Last weekend, both the Yellow Jacket men and women placed second of five teams at the annual "Sparky" Adams Invitational in Berea. Leading the way for the women was junior **Stacy Havaich (Austintown Fitch)** as she won both the 500 and 800-meter runs. For the men, senior **Dash McNeal (Crooksville)** led the way and won both the high jump and triple jump. Also, junior **Alex Johnson (Berea/ Olmsted Falls)** qualified for the Division III national indoor meet by winning the shot put with a career-best indoor throw of 51-feet and one-half inches.

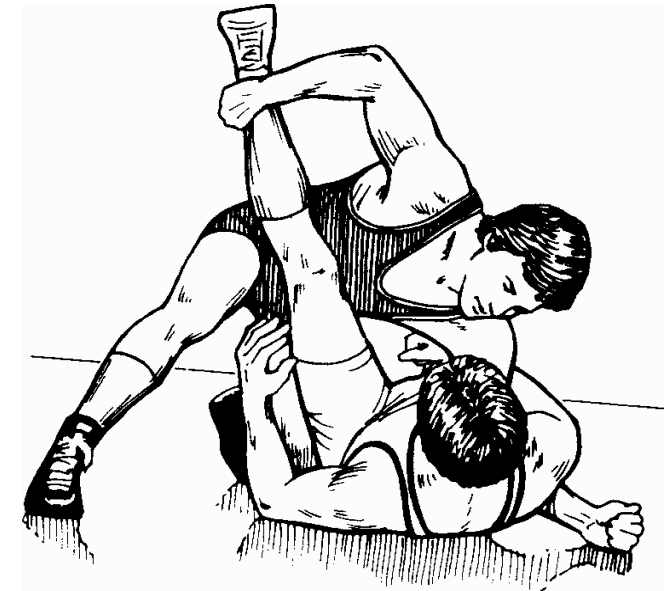
B-W Faces CWRU on Feb. 22

Baldwin-Wallace College Hosts Ohio Athletic Conference Foe Ohio Northern University Tonight at Ursprung; The annual John Summa Memorial Tournament is this weekend in Berea

BEREA, OHIO -- Tonight, the Baldwin-Wallace College wrestling team will play host to Ohio Athletic Conference rival Ohio Northern University tonight in the Rudolph Ursprung Gymnasium. In addition, this weekend the B-W wrestlers will be back in action when they host the annual John Summa Memorial Tournament in the Ursprung Gymnasium on Saturday. It should be a great week of wrestling in Berea.

The Yellow Jackets enter tonight's dual match with a 7-4 overall and 2-2 Ohio Athletic Conference record following its fifth place finish of 16 teams at the annual Elmhurst (Ill.) College Al Hanke Invitational Tournament last weekend.

Leading the way was **Jared Selover** who had a 3-1 record and placed second individually. In addition, **Joe Heiland** was 4-1 and placed third, **Jeff Varney** was 3-2 and placed fourth and **Cory Wilson** was also 3-2 and placed fifth.

After eight weeks of competition, **Selover** and **Heiland** are tied for the most victories with 24 each. **Selover** is 24-5 and has a team-leading .828 winning percentage. **Heiland** is 24-6 and is tied with **Greg Hartlaub** with an .800 winning percentage. **Jeff Varney** is fourth in wins with 20 and is 20-9 overall. **Devin Carman** is fifth with 17 wins and is 17-5 overall with a .773 winning percentage. **Sayre Wuhr**, who has been out with an injury, is sixth in wins with 14 and is at 14-4 overall. Other solid records include **Sterling Sebek** at 10-4, **Dan DiSalvo** at 9-6, **Scott Conrath** at 11-11 and **Brian Tipka** at 9-5 overall. Individually, **Heiland** has the most takedowns with 75 and is followed by **Selover** with 52. **Selover** has the most escapes with 36 and **T. Terry** is second with 32. **Phillip Peak** has the most reversals with 11. **Selover** has the most near falls with 24, **Wuhr** is second with 19 and **Brian Tipka** is third with 17. **Hartlaub** has the most falls with nine.

Next Tuesday, B-W is at OAC rival Mount Union College for an OAC dual match at 7:30 p.m.
