Women's Basketball

The Yellow Jacket women's basketball team was 8-4 overall and 4-1 in the Ohio Athletic Conference prior to playing last night at Mount Union College. Last Saturday, January 2, the B-W women defeated OAC-rival Marietta College, 94-78, in the Ursprung Gymnasium in Berea.

Leading the way was sophomore **Katie Heinlen (Bucyrus/Wynford)** had a career-high 22 points and nine rebounds. The B-W women are home this Saturday to face Muskingum University at 3:00 p.m. in Berea in a game that will be taped and shown on SportsTime Ohio on a delay basis.

On Saturday, Jan. 16, the B-W women host the Second Annual "Take a Kid to the Game" Day and that contest also will be televised by STO.

Swimming and Diving

The swimming and diving teams are currently wrapping up two weeks of training and meets in Florida. They compete tomorrow (Friday, Jan. 8) against Ramapo (N.J.) in Cocoa Beach and then return home this Sunday, Jan. 10. 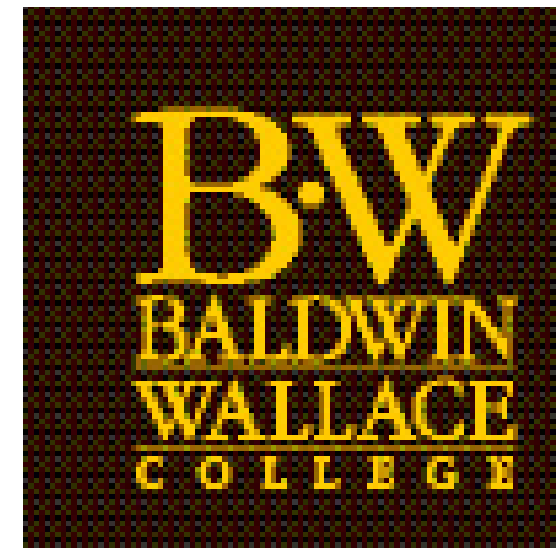

Men's Basketball

The men's basketball team was 7-5 overall and 2-3 in the OAC prior to hosting Mt. Union last night. The men last played on January 3 when they beat Alma (Mich.) College, 73-73, in Alma. Leading the way was senior All-OAC Forward **Kyle Brown (Strongsville)** with 17 points and five three-pointers. Also last week, the men won the Thomas More (Ky.) Coach Connor Classic with wins against Indiana University East and the host school. The three-game winning streak is the longest this season. Next Saturday, the men play at Muskingum University in New Concord at 3:00 p.m. The next home game is on Wednesday, Jan. 13 when B-W plays Ohio Northern University in the Ursprung Gym at 7:30 p.m.

The Yellow Jackets Host Central College of Iowa in a Dual Match Tonight at the Lou Higgins Center

BEREA, OHIO -- The Baldwin-Wallace Yellow Jackets, 2-6 overall, host perennial NCAA Division III wrestling power Central College of Iowa tonight in the Rudolph Ursprung Gymnasium of the Lou Higgins Center in Berea.

The Dutch enter tonight's match at 2-2 overall and defeated Wilmington College, 24-16, yesterday in Wilmington in a dual match. Central is currently en route to Collegeville, Pennsylvania to compete this weekend at the annual Ursinus (Pa.) College Duals.

The Yellow Jackets last competed two days ago when they lost to Ohio Athletic Conference foe Wilmington, 25-22, in Berea in their 2009-10 league opener. *View details on that match on the next page of this program.* B-W resumes its OAC schedule next Tuesday when it travels to New Concord, Ohio to face Muskingum University in a dual meet at 7:30 p.m.

B-W is led by junior **Tristian Stoll**, who has an 8-1 record at 197 pounds is third with 12 takedowns, tied for second with five reversals and three pins and first with eight near falls. Junior 133-pounder **Phil Payne** is second with an 8-3 mark, including a team-high 17 takedowns. Junior 285-pounder **Ryan Jones** is tied with both **Stoll** and **Payne** for second with eight wins and is tied for second with **Stoll** with three pins. Junior 174-pound 2009 OAC Champ and NCAA Division III national qualifier **Andrew Scavuzzo** has the most victories with nine, including an 8-2 slate at 174 and a 1-0 mark at 184 pounds, and is second with 13 takedowns. He is inactive for this match. Junior 157-pounder **Korey Leonhard** is next with seven wins, a 7-5 mark and a team-leading six reversals.

In terms of a starting lineup, look for sophomore **Jeremy Dombrady** to be at 125 pounds, **Payne** or freshman **Danny Huffman** at 133 pounds, senior **Eric Schubert** at 141 pounds, sophomore **Grant Steward** at 149, **Leonard** at 157, sophomore **Mike Hosta** at 165, junior **Cody Quick** at 184, **Stoll** at 197 and **Jones** at 285.

Following tonight's match, the B-W grapplers are off until Tuesday, Jan. 12 when they travel to New Concord, Ohio and face OAC rival Muskingum University in the Muskingum HPER Center at 7:30 p.m.

Following today's match, B-W has two more home dual matches when they face Mount Union College on Jan. 26 at 7:30 p.m. and against OAC and Cleveland cross-town rival John Carroll University at 7:30 p.m.

BEREA, OHIO -- The Baldwin-Wallace College wrestling team last competed two days ago when it lost to Ohio Athletic Conference rival Wilmington College, 25-22, in its OAC opener in the Ursprung Gymnasium in Berea.
