The Yellow Jacket women's basketball team, 13-4 overall and in first place in the Ohio Athletic Conference at 9-1, hosts John Carroll University tomorrow night in the Ursprung Gymnasium for a 7:30 p.m. game versus the cross-town rival Blue Streaks. Berea. To date, junior 4-time NCAA Division III All-American **Todd Richert (North Royalton)** has led the way.

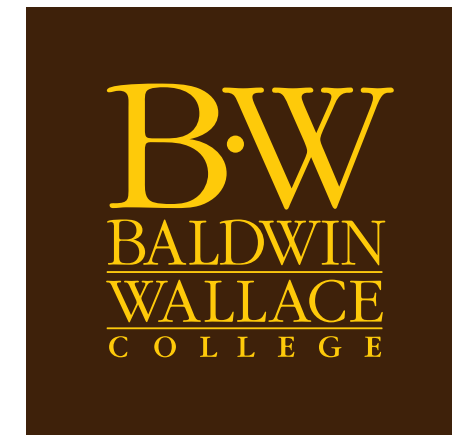
Indoor Track

The Yellow Jackets Host Mount Union College in an OAC Dual Match Tonight at the Lou Higgins Center

BEREA, OHIO -- The Baldwin-Wallace Yellow Jackets, 4-11 overall and 0-3 in the Ohio Athletic Conference, hosts arch-rival Mount Union College tonight in a dual match in the Rudolph Ursprung Gymnasium inside the Lou Higgins Center in Berea. The Purple Raiders enter tonight's match at 6-3 overall and 2-1 in the OAC.

The Yellow Jackets last competed on Tuesday, Jan. 19 when they lost 38-3, at 23-ranked (NWCA) Heidelberg University in Tiffin. In that match, junior Tristan Stoll picked up the lone B-W win with an 8-2 decision at 197 pounds.

For the season, B-W is led by **Stoll**, junior 174-pound 2009 OAC champ and NCAA Division III national qualifier **Andrew Scavuzzo**, sophomore heavyweight **Ryan Jones**, junior 157-pounder **Korey Leonhard** and junior 133-pounder **Phillip Payne**.

To date, **Stoll** posts an overall record of 13-2 and a 2-0 mark in the OAC with a team-high seven pins. **Scavuzzo** is 10-3 at 174 pounds and 11-3 overall with four pins. **Jones** is 13-6 overall with four pins. **Leonhard** is 12-7 overall with a 2-1 OAC mark. **Payne** is 11-7 with two pins.

In terms of a starting lineup, look for sophomore **Tyler Erwin** to be at 125 pounds, **Payne** at 133, **Eric Schubert** at 141, **Grant Steward** at 149, **Leonhard** at 157, sophomore **Mike Hosta** at 165, **Scavuzzo** at 174, junior **Cody Quick** at 184, **Stoll** at 197 and **Jones** at 285.

In the last meeting between B-W and Mt. Union on January 20, 2009, the Purple Raiders defeated the Yellow Jackets, 31-6. **Scavuzzo** and then freshman 125-pounder **Jeremy Dombrady** each won by decision.

Following tonight's match, the B-W grapplers next compete on Tuesday, February 2 at rival Ohio Northern University. Action from the ONU Sports Center in Ada is set for 7:30 p.m. B-W also hosts the 24th Annual John Summa Memorial Tournament on Saturday, February 6 and wraps up the regular season on Tuesday, February 9 versus rival John Carroll University at 7:30 p.m. in Berea.

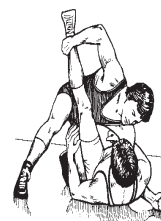
