



Senior 141-Pounder Eric Schubert

Tonight, Baldwin-Wallace College senior 141-pounder **Eric Schubert (Oberlin)** will compete in his final home match as a Yellow Jacket. He is a four-year mainstay in the starting lineup for the Yellow Jackets. His hard work, dedication, commitment and undying love for the B-W program will be sorely missed. Eric is the son of Woody and Susan Schubert of Oberlin, Ohio.

MAJOR: Early Childhood Education

CAREER AMBITION: Eric would like to be a teacher and coach.

SPORTS PLAYED AT B-W (YEARS AND LETTERS WON): As a senior in 2009-2010, Eric is competing in his fourth season of wrestling. He has earned three varsity letters.

ACADEMIC HONORS AND GROUPS AT B-W: As a senior in 2008-2009, Eric was awarded the John Summa Memorial Wrestling Prize and served as the Vice President of the Student-Athlete Advisory Committee. As a freshman in 2006-2007, Eric was named a Jacket Scholar.

GENERAL NOTES & OTHER INFORMATION: As a freshman in 2006-2007, Eric earned his first varsity letter. He was the starter at 125 pounds and compiled a 9-19 record with 16 takedowns, 27 escapes, five reversals and nine total near falls. He was credited with one pin. At the 2007 Ohio Athletic Conference Championship Tournament, Eric placed fourth and helped the Yellow Jackets finish second as a team.

As a sophomore in 2007-2008, Eric competed in his second season of wrestling and earned his second varsity letter. He was the starter at 141 pounds and compiled a 9-23 record with 12 takedowns, 22 escapes, 11 reversals and eight total near falls. He was credited with one pin. Individually, Eric placed fourth at 141 pounds at the OAC Tournament. B-W finished fourth as a team and was tied for 32nd at the NCAA Division III National Tournament.

As a junior in 2008-2009, Eric earned his third varsity letter. He split time at the 141 and 149-pound weight classes and went a combined 6-17 overall. Eric recorded 20 takedowns, 31 escapes and five reversals.

As a senior in 2009-2010, Eric is having his best season as a collegian, competing mainly at 141 pounds and serving as a team captain. He has compiled a 9-13 record with 24 takedowns and a team-high 30 escapes.

GENERAL NOTES & OTHER INFORMATION: As a freshman in 2006-2007, Cody had a 1-6 record with three takedowns while competing at 165 pounds.

As a sophomore in 2007-2008, Cody split mat time between 157 and 165 pounds. He was 2-4 at each weight class for an overall record of 4-8. Cody had nine takedowns, four escapes and one reversal.

As a junior in 2008-2009, Cody missed a majority of the season and competed at 165 pounds, 197 pounds and even once at heavyweight. He won his only heavyweight match by pin and finished with six overall takedowns, six escapes and one nearfall.

As a senior in 2009-10, Cody is B-W's starting 184-pounder after beginning the season at 197 pounds. He has posted a career-best five wins, including four at 184. He has 14 takedowns and 10 escapes.
