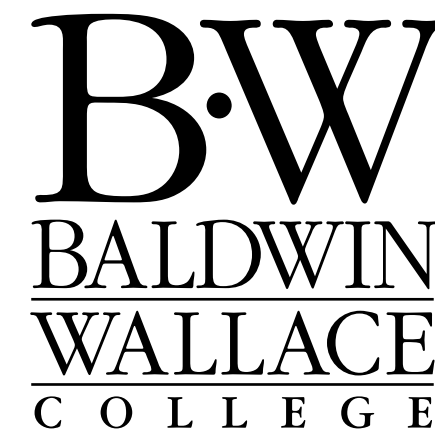

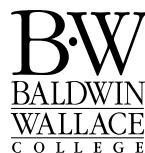

### Yellow Jackets Open Their 2006 Home Schedule Against Heidelberg College Tonight in Berea

**BEREA, OHIO** -- The Baldwin-Wallace College wrestling team, 4-3 overall, hosts Ohio Athletic Conference rival Heidelberg College tonight in its home opener for 2006-2007.

The Yellow Jackets will be competing for the third time this season. B-W opener the season with a 2-1 record at the Case Western Reserve University Quad Meet on November 11 and then had a 2-2 mark at the Olivet College of Michigan Duals on Nov. 18. Heidelberg enters this match with a 6-0 record and is the pick of the OAC Coaches to win this year's OAC Dual Match and OACTournament championships.

B-W is picked to finish second by the OAC Coaches this season and is expected to have an even better team later in the season when three full time starters come back from conditioning, injury and for the second semester. For now, Brian Bucher, Mo Salem, Gino Russo and Jeremy Feador will have to continue leading the team. Bucher and Salem enter tonight's match at 6-1 overall and start at 133 and 149 pounds, respectively. Russo is currently wrestling 165 and is 5-1 and Feador is the starter at 174 pounds and is at 5-0. Look for the quartet to be joined as starters by Eric Schubert at 125 pounds, RayShawn Eatmon at 141, Joe Incorvaia at 157, either Bryan Gulich, Antonio Campea or Arlon Brister at 184, Tavis Sokolow at 197 and either Mike Pelton or transfer Paul Burger at 285.

Burger is just getting into wrestling shape after ending an All-OAC football season as a linebacker 17 days ago. The transfer from Division II Edinboro (Pa.) State University is expected to eventually compete at 197 pounds and be a strong addition to the team.

In addition, look for the Yellow Jacket lineup to be bolstered by the return of both senior Division III All-American Jared Selover in mid-to-late December after suffering an unusual injury combination and senior OAC 285-pound champion and 2005-2006 Division III National Qualifier Bryan Kmetz at 285 pounds. Selover is 61-18 in his career and Kmetz, who was 23-2 last season, is 72-13 in his career with 19 pins and three straight OAC championship match appearances. In addition, junior Kenny Jones returns to the program in January.

A year ago, Russo earned All-OAC honors with a second place finish and had a team-high 28 wins and a 28-5 record. Feador, who placed fourth at the OAC Tournament. In addition, Salem was 18-11 a year ago as a freshman in a tough weight class. So far this fall, Fleming also credits the improvements made by Bucher and Salem as well as others from a year ago and the additions of Burger, Schubert and Sokolow as being a reason to have an optimistic view this winter.

"We have already exceeded my early season expectations and I am very optimistic about this team," said veteran Head Coach Rich Fleming, in his 18th season at B-W and the second winningest wrestling coach in school history. "They all work very hard in practice and each one has a great attitude. We will be able to compete with a lot of good teams providing we also stay relatively healthy."

#### Women's Basketball Update

The ninth-ranked women's basketball team is 2-1 overall and hosts traditional rival Oberlin College in its next game tomorrow night, Wednesday, November 29 at 7:30 p.m. in the Ursprung Gymnasium

The B-W women last played on Tuesday when they beat Cleveland cross-town rival Case Western Reserve University, 78-50, in the first game of a doubleheader in Berea. Sophomore All-Ohio Athletic Conference guard **Amanda Mondrach (Parma/ Holy Name)** led the Jackets' with 14 points. The women open OAC play at home against Capital University on December 2 at 3:00 p.m.

#### Men's Basketball Update

The men's basketball team is 3-1 overall following its 74-71 victory against Olivet College of Michigan last Saturday in Berea. Senior All-American forward **Tori Davis (Elyria/ Open Door)** led the way to victory with a season-high 30 points and 11 rebounds and canned a pair of foul shots with 1:11 left in the game to put B-W on top for good. In addition, freshman guard **Louis Tumblin (Elyria/ Senior)** had a career-high 14 points. #### The Swimming Update

The men's and women's swimming & diving teams are a third of the way through their season. To date, each team is 5-3 overall and 2-0 versus Ohio Athletic Conference competition. Both teams will next compete from this coming Friday, Dec. 1 through Sunday, Dec. 3, at the SUNY/Fredonia Invitational in Fredonia, New York.

#### The Indoor Track Update

The men's and women's track teams will begin the season when they host the Mid-January Meet on Friday, January 19 on the Harrison Dillard Indoor Track in the Lou Higgins Center. This season the women's team will look to defend both the Ohio Athletic Conference and Division III All-Ohio Championship titles. The men's team is expected to be better.

#### B-W Enjoys Another Outstanding Fall Season in 2006

The fall season came to a close last Saturday (Nov. 18) when sophomore **Ashley Scullion (Kentwood, Mich./ East Kentwood)** placed 144th at the NCAA Division III National Cross Country Meet at Wilmington College. Overall, it was an outstanding fall season for the College and its student-athletes.

The volleyball team finished 26-7 overall and was the OAC regular season co-champion. Senior All-American setter **Angie Camp (Norwalk/ St. Paul)** was B-W's first two-time All-American in volleyball and its first OAC *Player of the Year*. The men's soccer team finished 13-4-1 overall and was led by senior **Louie Rolko (Hudson)** who won his second straight OAC *Midfielder of the Year* award and *ESPN THE MAGAZINE* Academic All-Americans in senior **Tommy Ehrnfelt (Strongsville)** and **Matt Pietro (Canfield)**. The women's soccer team was 10-8 overall and had its third straight 10-win or more season. The football team was 7-3 overall and had its 39th winning season in the last 40 years and Head Coach John Snell was the OAC *Co-Coach of the Year*. The men's cross country team had a winning record and placed fourth at the OAC Championships which was an improvement over 2005. The men's golf team had a 29-11 mark in the fall and won two invitational tournament titles and the women were 25-15-1 overall. Both teams have a great shot at winning OAC titles when their spring seasons resume in early March.
