

Two Yellow Jacket Senior Wrestlers Compete for the Final Time in the Brown & Gold in the Rudolph Ursprung Gymnasium

Bryan Kmetz is competing in his fourth season of wrestling and has been one of the best 285-pounder in Division III since the day he stepped on the mat. This season, Bryan has compiled an impressive 12-0 record, is ranked fourth nationally in Division III and is having his best season as a collegian. During his career, he was the Most Valuable Wrestler at the RIT Tournament and three times was named as the OAC *Wrestler of the Week*. Bryan did not compete as a freshman, instead choosing to concentrate on his academics. As a sophomore, Bryan earned a varsity letter, was the OAC *Wrestler of the Week*, compiled a 28-5 overall record with a team-leading .848 winning percentage and finished second and earned All-OAC honors at the OAC Championships. As a junior, Bryan compiled an impressive 21-6 record with a team-leading 33 near falls, was the B-W John Summa Trny. MVP and again earned All-OAC accolades with a second place showing at the OAC tourney. Last year, he had a 19-2 mark, won his first-ever OAC title, again was an OAC *Wrestler of the Week* and competed at the NCAA Division III National Championship Meet. This season, Bryan returned to the mat in January and is seeking a second straight OAC title and NCAA berth. Last weekend, he won a title at the 21st Annual John Summa Memorial Tournament.

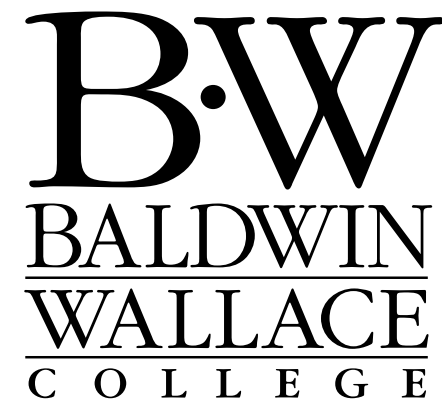

Jared Selover returned to the mat last week after missed most of the past three seasons due to injuries suffered in a severe automobile accident. As a freshman wrestling at 125 pounds, Jared earned OAC *Wrestler of the Week*. He also was the 125-pound OAC champion and earned a bid to the NCAA Division III National Championships. He was named OAC John Summa *Most Outstanding Wrestler* (OAC MVP) for his 35-8 record, placed fourth and earned All-American honors. As a sophomore, Jared was named OAC *Wrestler of the Week* and also earned All-OAC honors after placing second at the OAC tourney at 133 pounds. Jared received the John Summa Memorial Wrestling Prize at the 2005-2006 B-W Honors Day ceremony. Jared is one of only six B-W wrestlers to ever win 30 or more matches in a single season. Last season and again this season, Jared has battled injuries to continue to compete and shown "the heart of a champion" in the process.

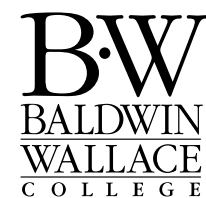

The Yellow Jackets Face OAC Rival Muskingum With Their Healthiest Lineup of the Season

BEREA, OHIO -- The Baldwin-Wallace College wrestling team ends its 2006-2007 regular season tonight when the Yellow Jackets face Ohio Athletic Conference rival Muskingum College in the Ursprung Gymnasium. It is Seniors' Night and seniors **Bryan Kmetz** and **Jared Selover** will compete for the final time in the Brown & Gold. *Profiles of the two senior standouts are on the back outside cover of this program.*

The Yellow Jacket wrestling team enters this match with an 11-10 overall and 3-2 OAC record following an outstanding showing at last weekend's 21st Annual John Summa Memorial Tournament in Berea. B-W has its healthiest lineup of the season and is pointing toward being a serious contender for the 2007 OAC title. The OAC Championship Tournament is February 17 at Heidelberg College, and look for B-W to be one of three teams to have a legitimate shot to win the title.

Last Saturday at the Summa Tournament, B-W finished second of 10 schools. B-W scored 117 points and placed second to Brockport State (N.Y.) College which won an 11th straight Summa tourney title with 129 points. Thiel College of Pennsylvania was third with 107.5 points. Highlighting the tourney was 174-pounder **Jeremy Feador** who was the *Most Valuable Wrestler* and won the *Most Pins* award. In addition, **Kmetz** won a title at 285 pounds and 197-pounder **Paul Burger** each won individual titles. Also, **Selover** was second at 133 pounds, **Brian Bucher** at 133, **Mo Salem** at 149 pounds and **Antonio Campea** at 184 pounds all placed third and **Bryan Haines** was fourth at 184.

Feador won all three of his matches by pin en route to being the MVP. He pinned Igor Babuskin of Rochester Institute of Technology (N.Y.) in his first match in 1:55, then pinned Bryan Gomez of Morrisville State (N.Y.) College in 1:46 and ended his "pin-fest" by pancaking Eric Van Patten of Brockport State in 1:46. The trio of pins him the Most Pins Award. He is now 18-8 this season with a team-best 10 pins. **Burger** won his title with a 3-0 record and had a pin, a major decision and another decision. He pinned Mike Tees of Tri-State (Ind.) in his first match in 2:22, beat Rob Northrup of Brockport State in the semifinals, 9-4, and then defeated Brockport's Steve Spiegeliere, 11-2, in the championship match. Burger is now 5-1 this season. **Kmetz** had a 4-0 record with a pair of pins and a pair of decisions. In his first two matches, he pinned Melvin Warrick of Waynesburg (Pa.) College in 1:13 and then flatened Justin Talkington of Tri-State in 42 seconds before beating Micah Vore of RIT, 9-6, in the semifinals. In the championship match, he defeated Kyle Brown from Thiel (Pa.), 7-4. It is the second time this season that **Kmetz** beat Brown. **Kmetz** remained undefeated this season at 12-0 with seven pins.

To date, **Bucher** tops the team with 22 wins, has a 22-7 mark and also leads the team with 17 reversals and 35 near falls. **Salem** is second with 21 wins, is 21-11 overall, tops the squad with 27 escapes and is second with 43 takedowns and 33 near falls. **Feador** is tied for third with his 18 wins with All-OAC 165-pounder **Gino Russo**, who is 18-4 overall and tops the team with 49 takedowns. **Kmetz**, ranked fourth in Division III in his weight class, is a perfect 12-0. **Campea** with 12 wins and sophomore 157-pounder **Joe Incorvaia** with 11 victories round out the double figure winners.

Following the OAC Championship Meet, the 2007 NCAA Division III National Championship Tournament is March 2-3 at Loras College in Dubuque, Iowa. *An entire list of Yellow Jacket results for 2006-2007 is listed on the back outside cover of this program.*

The Women's Basketball Update

The nationally-ranked and defending Ohio Athletic Conference champion Baldwin-Wallace College women's basketball team, 17-4 overall and 11-3 in the Ohio Athletic Conference, next plays at home tomorrow night against Otterbein College in the Ursprung Gymnasium at 7:30 p.m.

Last Saturday (Feb. 3), the Yellow Jacket women defeated first place Wilmington College, 69-62, in Berea and moved B-W to within one game of first place. To date, the team is led in scoring by junior forward **Carly Flowers (North Baltimore)** with 11.6 points per game.

The B-W women also play this Saturday (Feb. 10) at Muskingum College at 3:00 p.m. With three more victories, the Yellow Jacket women will secure an 11th straight 20-win season. Since the streak began in 1996-97 and B-W has compiled a 262-49 record, including this season. The current senior class enters the Otterbein game with a 90-19 record.

The Men's Basketball Update

The defending OAC champion Yellow Jacket men's basketball team, 13-8 overall and 8-6 in the OAC, plays at Otterbein College tomorrow night in Westerville. Fans can listen to that game live on campus radio station WBWC, 88.3 FM. The pregame show begins at 7:20 p.m.

In its first meeting earlier this season, Otterbein defeated B-W, 95-88 in overtime in Berea. Two Yellow Jackets scored in double figures, led by senior All-American forward **Tori Davis (Elyria)** with a game-high 30 points. In addition, junior All-OAC guard **Brendan Schuler (Fairview Park)** had 11 points.

The B-W men last played on Saturday (Feb. 3) when they lost at Wilmington College, 75-68, in Wilmington. Despite the loss, **Davis** had 19 points and 12 rebounds and **Schuler** chipped in with 17 points.

The Yellow Jacket host Muskingum College this Saturday (Feb. 10) at 3:00 p.m. in the Ursprung Gym.

The Men's and Women's Swimming Update

The men's and women's swimming and diving teams are idle until they compete at the 2007 OAC Championships on Feb. 15-17 at the University of Akron.

Both the men and women finished the regular season with a 6-5 overall record and 3-1 record in the OAC.

The Men's and Women's Indoor Track and Field Update

The men's and women's track teams will host the B-W Mid-February Meet this Friday on the Dillard Track in the Lou Higgins Center Fieldhouse. Events get underway at 4:15 p.m. Also, on Saturday, the Yellow Jackets compete at the 2007 All-Ohio Indoor Championship Meet at Otterbein College. That meet gets underway at 11:00 a.m.

Last Friday (Feb 2), B-W competed in the Case Western Reserve Meet and the women won their first meet title of the season, were first of 12 schools and had three individual champs. The men placed second of 10 teams and had two champs. For the women, junior **Kristen Paulsen (Oberlin)** won the 55-meter hurdles, freshman **Jennifer Miller (Gnad-enhutten)** won the pole vault and freshman **Jordan Hill (Carrollton)** won the 300-meter dash. For the men, senior **Steve Johnson (Canton)** won the pole vault and sophomore **Alan Kidon (Chardon)** won the 300-meter dash.

B-W also hosts the 2007 Greater Cleveland College Indoor Championship Meet on Friday, Feb. 16 at 4:15 p.m.
