Yellow Jacket Sports Report

BEREA, OHIO -- The Baldwin-Wallace College fall sports season is going very well. The 10 Yellow Jacket fall teams have a combined 156-76 record with a solid .672 winning percentage entering tonight's action. Nine of our 10 teams have winning record with four of the teams having completed fall action. They are the men's and women's tennis and men's and women's golf squads.

The men's soccer team, 13-2 overall and 4-1 in the OAC, is playing host to Mount Union tomorrow night on the Tressel Field pitch.

The football team, 5-1 and 4-1 in the OAC, defeated Ohio Northern University, 20-6, last Saturday on Homecoming. Senior linebacker **Brett Thompson (Shelby)** was named the *Frank Ropollo Player of the Game* after setting the school and The George Finnie Stadium-record with a 95-yard interception return for a touchdown. Senior defensive end **Derron Hamilton (Euclid)** leads Division III in quarterback sacks with 11. Junior running back **Tyler Lohr (Kent/ Roosevelt)** leads the team in rushing with 641 yards and had his third straight 100-yard plus game against Ohio Northern. The team returns to action this Saturday, October 22 when it will travel to Wilmington to play the Quakers of Wilmington College at Townsend Field in Williams Stadium at 1:30 p.m. The next home game is on Saturday, October 29 when B-W hosts the Fighting Muskies of Muskingum University on Professor Appreciation Day at 1:30 p.m.

The volleyball team was 14-11 overall and 2-3 in the OAC prior to its match last night at Mount Union. Junior outside hitter **Amanda Sawicki (Mentor/ Lake Catholic)** leads the offense and is second in the OAC with 309 kills. Junior setter **Natalie Emmons (Ashland/ Senior)** anchors the defense and is third in the OAC with 479 digs. The next home match is on Tuesday, October 25 when the team hosts cross-town rival John Carroll University in its annual "Dig Pink" match in the Rudolph Ursprung Gymnasium in the Lou Higgins Center at 7:00 p.m.

The men's and women's cross country teams competed in its fifth meet of the season at the Oberlin College Inter-Regional last Saturday. The men finished 16th of 34 schools and the women were sixth of 33 teams. Junior **Ken Janosko (Mentor)** led the men and placed sixth of 315 runners. He has led the Yellow Jackets in each of their five meets this fall. Junior **Lauren McGaughey (Allison Park, Pa./ Hampton)** paced the women with a 22nd place finish. It was her first team top finish this season. Each team returns to action on Saturday, October 29 when they travel to Ada to compete in the 2011 OAC Championship Meet hosted by Ohio Northern at 11:00 a.m.

The men's and women's swimming and diving teams open their season next Saturday, October 29 when the teams play host to the Quakers of Wilmington College in an OAC dual meet at 4:00 p.m.

The Yellow Jacket wrestling team begins action under first-year Head Coach Jamie Gibbs with a dual match against Case Western Reserve University on November 11 at 7:30 p.m. in the Ursprung Gym.

The men's and women's basketball seasons kickoff on Tuesday, November 15 with a doubleheader in the Ursprung Gym at 6:00 (men's game) and 8:00 p.m. (women's game), respectively.

Yellow Jacket Women's Soccer Team Hosts Mount Union In OAC Showdown

BEREA, OHIO -- The Baldwin-Wallace College women's soccer team, 8-7 overall and 1-4 in the Ohio Athletic Conference plays host to the University of Mount Union, 7-6-2 overall and 2-3 in the OAC, on Tressel Field at The George Finnie Stadium.

The Yellow Jackets come into the match after dropping a pair of OAC matches last week to Heidelberg, 1-0, on October 12 and then, 2-0, to 18th-ranked (*NSCAA Division III Coaches national poll*) Ohio Northern University on Saturday.

The Yellow Jackets are led by **Heather Keller** with a team-high-tying four goals and a team-best five assists for 13 points. **Lindsey Cooper** and Rachel Gokey are tied for second with nine points. Cooper has contributed a team-high-tying four goals and one assist and **Rachel Gokey** has tallied three goals and three assists. Kayla Losco is fourth with a team-high-tying four goals for eight points.

In net, B-W has used a trio of goalkeepers. **Gabrielle Bodo** has started in 10 games and has a record of 4-6. **Bodo** has recorded a team-best 41 saves while allowing 16 goals for a 1.57 goals-against-average. **Claire LoPresti** has appeared in five games with four starts in net. **LoPresti** is 3-1 and has tallied 11 saves and a 0.62 GAA. **Kristina Mathur** has appeared in three games and has started in one match. **Mathur** has a record of 1-0 with three saves and a 0.53 GAA.

Mount Union comes into the match after splitting a pair of OAC matches last week by falling to John Carroll 1-0 on October 12 and defeating Heidelberg, 2-0, on Saturday, October 15.

The Purple Raiders are led by Kylee Kolesar with six goals and a team-high six assists for 18 points while Alyssa Flitcraft is second on the team with a team-high eight goals and one assist for 17 points.

Netminder Jackie Podolsky anchors the defense. She has tallied 40 saves and allowed just 10 goals in 12 games for a 1.29 GAA.

The Yellow Jackets are back in action on Saturday, September 22 when they host the Quakers of Wilmington College on Seniors' and Parent's Day in the first game of a men's and women's soccer doubleheader at 4:30 p.m. The men kickoff at 7:00 p.m.
