### ***Intramurals***

Tournaments and leagues are offered throughout the academic year and consist of individuals and teams of all ability levels. ### ***Club Sports***

### ***Recreation***

Outdoor Recreation allows you an opportunity to develop a greater appreciation of nature by providing outdoor recreation activities. Trips are offered on a seasonal basis throughout the academic year and are open to all students, faculty and staff. There are annual sailing trips in the Florida Keys, White Water Adventures in the Gully River, ski trips to the slopes in NY and WV, and camping trips throughout the year.

Leisure Recreation consists of non-credit courses developed for the specific purpose of improving and maintaining the physical fitness of our students, faculty and staff. The sessions typically run for six to ten weeks and are led by highly trained instructors in each activity.

Other services available include recreational equipment rentals and outdoor recreation programming, as well as non-credit workshops and clinics. Other facilities include Finnie Stadium (8,200 seat football, soccer and track complex), Heritage Field (baseball), and the "Pop" Collins Tennis Complex.
