

Fast Facts: Baldwin-Wallace College

- B-W is 14 miles southwest of Cleveland.
- Approximately 3,050 full-time undergraduate students attend B-W.
- The student to faculty ratio is 15:1, and the average class size is 19.
- There are 23 Housing options for about 2,000 resident students (www.bw.edu/stulife/reslife).
- B-W has a variety of traditional residence halls and apartment-style housing including a freshman complex, wellness residence halls, upperclass residence halls, and the Carmel Living Learning Center (housing academic and honors programs).
- 96% of first year B-W students receive some sort of financial aid assistance and more than 80% of first-year students receive a merit-based scholarship.
- B-W offers over 50 majors all taught by faculty members (no graduate assistants).

- B-W offers countless computers for student use located in labs throughout campus. The campus is wireless, and there are internet hookups in each room for those students who wish to bring their own computers.

- B-W offers more than 120 clubs & organizations for students to join including academic, community service, commuter, athletic, and social related activities.
- B-W offers 21 competitive intercollegiate athletic teams at the NCAA Division III level.
- B-W offers over 60 competitive intramural and club sports.
- B-W is ranked 11th in the Midwest by the U.S. News and World Report. In addition, B-W is also ranked in the category of Best Values.
