Local students in your area may request personal interviews off campus. Generally, these students are unable to visit campus. Interviews are conducted in the fall through early spring. These requests will be handled on an individual basis.

Interviews allow alumni and parents to become invested in the admission process by meeting and connecting with individuals who may become the next generation of B-W alumni. The young people who request alumni interviews are keen on making a good impression. The impression you make on them and how you promote the College are equally important.

Objectives

- Stress B-W's strengths as they relate to the student's interests.
- Supplement the information the admission office has about the student.
