



Associate to Bachelor at B-W (A2B)

BA in Organizational Leadership

Students who hold an associate's degree from a regionally accredited college may complete the BA in Organizational Leadership with a minor in Human Resources in as few as 21 courses (62.5 credit hours)*.

Designed for working adults, this program may be completed full-time or part-time, attending evenings and Saturdays. The A2B in Organizational Leadership is also available entirely [online](#).

As part of their associate degree program, students may have completed some of the A2B courses. Students may transfer a maximum of 3 equivalent courses to the A2B program, and these courses must then be supplemented with other B-W courses so that the student completes 21 courses at Baldwin-Wallace College.
