- ***The Quick Start Application is designed to give adults greater flexibility and access in enrolling in a few college courses for one semester... prior to formally enrolling at Baldwin-Wallace College as a degree-seeking or continuing student.*** Often the decision to go back to school is hindered more by the time it takes to get started than by the student's level of motivation and readiness to learn. The Quick Start Program has helped hundreds of adults take that important first step...by providing **one semester** to enroll in a course or two, before completing the regular application process. An option provided through the Evening/Weekend Program, Quick Start enrollment is intended for adults age 23 and older.
- ***The Quick Start Application is just one page long, does not require official academic transcripts and can often be approved the same day.*** Student-held copies of transcripts should be shared with a counselor for admission assessment and to assist with course selection. If you have ever been placed on probation, suspension or dismissed by a college or university, that information must be disclosed for consideration by the Admission Committee.
- ***Quick Start admission provides part-time enrollment for one semester.*** To continue beyond the first semester, Quick Start students must complete the regular admission process which includes a formal application and review of all previous academic work, as well as an assessment of other strengths that support admission to the College. The Quick Start option does not guarantee full, degree-seeking admission to Baldwin-Wallace College, however any coursework taken at B-W as a Quick Start student becomes part of the permanent record and may be used toward degree and certificate requirements.
- ***Quick Start students may be eligible for alternative educational loans to help fund the cost of their education.*** Although Quick Start students are not eligible for federal, state and college financial aid (Stafford loans, grants, College Work/Study or scholarships), many major banks offer alternative loans that are specifically for part-time and/or non-degree students. The Financial Aid Office can help students understand their options and can be reached at 440-826-2108.
- ***The Office of Admission will assist Quick Start students with an unofficial evaluation of transfer credit to be used as a guide in course selection on a short-term basis.*** Once admitted through the formal admission process, an official evaluation of transfer credit is provided by the Office of Registration and Records.
