- * Due to construction across campus since last year, there have been some changes:
 - ** Telfer/Wilker Hall now have handicapped access; and
 - ** Merner-Pfeiffer Hall is currently closed.
- * The B&G priority snow route is implemented during snow and ice events.
- * When snow accumulates 2 in. or greater or when icy conditions exist, the route will cover one entrance to every building, which will be the handicapped entrance.
- * Main access route from North Campus to South Campus is the intersection of Beech Street and Bagley Rd. At times this may be the only opened route from North to South Campus due to city snow plowing of Bagley Road.
- * During heavy snowfalls the primary snow routes will continually be plowed and salted. Secondary routes will not be opened until snowfall stops and primary routes are done and can be safely navigated.
- * Primary routes are priority throughout the day until early evening.
- * As events dictate, other areas on campus will be maintained also (e.g. night classes and special events).
- * We will also strive to keep handicapped parking spaces as priorities in all parking lots.
- * For visually impaired crossing of Bagley Road, please use the Bagley Road - Beech Street crossing, which will have the voice instructions for crossing.
- * PLEASE USE CAUTION AROUND THE SNOW-REMOVAL EQUIPMENT.
