The Division of Business Administration of Baldwin-Wallace College invites applications for a full-time, tenure track position in finance. We seek a candidate who has demonstrated effectiveness in teaching introductory, intermediate, and advanced courses in finance and who identifies with our passion for blending theory and practice to assure that undergraduate, graduate, and non-traditional students receive the practical and principled education in finance they warrant. Experience with international finance, financial institutions, and investments are a plus. Additional responsibilities include student advising/mentoring, service on College and Division committees, and continuing professional development. Preference will be given to candidates with a commitment to student learning, collaborative program building and a willingness to support the College's general education program. A Ph.D. in the field is preferred, but, individuals with advanced degrees and significant experience will be considered. Individuals with prior teaching experience, the ability to show evidence of innovative and practiced-based teaching, and on-line course development experience are encouraged to apply. A demonstrated track-record of working with students, colleagues, and community members that offer and bring multicultural and intercultural perspectives related to the business community, particularly in the area of finance is expected.

The Division of Business Administration offers eight different undergraduate majors to approximately 800 students. The seven unique MBA Programs are taught to 475 students.
