

NON-DEGREE APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION INSTRUCTIONS

QUICK START PROGRAM

Quick Start provides a one-semester admission for up to 9 credit hours prior to formally enrolling as a degree-seeking or continuing student.

Completed application for admission. No application fee is required.

Student-held copies of transcripts should be shared with a counselor for admission assessment and to assist with course selection. If you have been placed on probation, suspension or dismissed by a college or university, that information must be disclosed for consideration by the Admission Committee.

To continue beyond the first semester, Quick Start students must complete the regular admission process. The Quick Start option does not guarantee full, degree-seeking admission to BW; however, any coursework taken at BW as a Quick Start student becomes part of the permanent record and may be used toward degree and certificate requirements.

TRANSIENT STATUS

Transient status allows students from another college or university to enroll at BW for one semester, with the purpose of transferring that coursework back to their home institution. If you wish to continue as a transient student, you must reapply each term.

To qualify as a Transient Student at BW, students must have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.0 and be considered in good academic standing at their home institution.

Completed application for admission. No application fee is required.

Request for Verification of Enrollment Form from the college/university where you are currently enrolled confirming that you are a student in good standing. See the inside back cover of this application for the Transient Student form.

POST-BACCALAUREATE PROGRAM

Post-Baccalaureate denotes an individual who has earned a bachelor's degree and wishes to take additional undergraduate courses.

Completed application for admission.

\$25.00 non-refundable application fee. Make your check payable to Baldwin Wallace University.

Official transcripts from college/university where degree was earned (unless otherwise requested). Transcripts must be mailed directly from the college/university attended to the BW Admission Office. See the Request for Official Transcript form on inside back cover of this application.

TEACHER LICENSURE PROGRAM

This non-degree application is available to licensed teachers who wish to renew a certificate/license or add a new area of licensure by taking additional undergraduate courses. Students interested in becoming a teacher for the first time should complete the TRANSFER AND ADULT STUDENT APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION online at www.bw.edu/apply/.

Completed application for admission.

\$25.00 non-refundable application fee. Make your check payable to Baldwin Wallace University.

Official transcripts from ALL colleges/universities attended. Transcripts must be mailed directly from each college/university attended to the BW Admission Office. All coursework attempted is part of your academic record and must be considered in the application process, even if that coursework is no longer consistent with your academic goals. The Education Division recommends a minimum GPA of 2.60 for admission. See Request for Official Transcript form on the inside back cover of this application.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Meet with an Admission Counselor

Meeting with an admission counselor gives us an opportunity to get to know you better, to answer your questions and discuss strengths and areas of your background that may not be easily communicated in the application. A counselor will discuss your educational plans and share how your previous college work may transfer to BW.

Financial Assistance


NOTIFICATION OF ADMISSION DECISION
