Prerequisite Guidelines & Requirements

- Candidates for the Accelerated BSN (ABSN) program must earn a C or above in all prerequisite courses. **Please** note, a cumulative prerequisite GPA of 3.0 is required to be considered for admission.
- Prerequisite courses must be completed at a regionally accredited college or university within the United States.
- The ABSN program will accept online courses and labs for prerequisite requirements.
- To ensure a working knowledge of these courses, all prerequisite courses must be completed within the **last seven years** of a candidate's intended start term (i.e. students interested in the fall 2025 cohort must have completed their prerequisites spring 2018 and beyond).
- Both the original and retaken course will be factored into the GPA calculation, and the better grade will be noted.
- **Prerequisites may be in process during the application and interview process**. Prerequisites must be completed prior to enrollment in the program (usually by the end of July).
