



## Principal License ONLINE Sequence (30 semester hours)

The Principal's Licensure program is two years and 30 semester hours (ten course program which includes two semesters of internship). The courses must be taken in sequential order. A master's degree is required to obtain a principal's license (42 semester hours).\*
