



## State Licensure Exam Results

### Reporting Notes:

Program completer pass rates are reported annually in the Title II report and published on our website. This report includes the past three years, which means pass rates are updated if program completers pass exams in the two years after they finish the program. The Ohio Department of Higher Education also publishes pass rates as part of their annual performance reports, but that data is from the prior academic year (meaning two years ago). To provide the most up to date and accurate data, we are going to publish the pass rates for our most recent completed year. This data comes from Pearson's ResultsAnalyzer and represents the best annual attempt for each program completer. We will also include disaggregated data for tests with an  $n > 3$  (Title II only report  $N > 10$ ).

**Additional information about state exams:****State Licensure Requirements**

The implementation of educator licensure testing in Ohio is in response to standards adopted by the State Board of Education. Ohio Assessments for Educators (OAE) are provided by Evaluation Systems group of Pearson. These assessments include the Assessment of Professional Knowledge (APK) and content tests. The edTPA is provided by the Stanford Center for Assessment, Learning, and Equity (SCALE). Tests in World Languages are provided by ACTFL/LTI and include two components: the Oral Proficiency Interview (OPI or OPIc) and the Writing Proficiency Test (WPT). Successful completion of the required licensure test(s) is designed to ensure that candidates for educator licensure have acquired the minimal knowledge necessary for entry-level positions.

The Ohio Department of Education (ODE) requires only ONE Assessment of Professional Knowledge be successfully completed in an educator's career. In December 2019, the State Board of Education adopted the edTPA as a licensure examination. Therefore, the Assessment of Professional Knowledge may be met through successful completion of edTPA or the Ohio Assessments for Educators (OAE) APK exam for the candidate's initial teaching grade band (again, only one APK is required, even if candidates are seeking more than one grade band). New content or licensure areas require additional subject tests to establish minimum competency in those subject areas. The ODE provides a regularly updated document to confirm Educator Licensure Testing Requirements.
